Outcome of the approval process:

The minutes from last meeting, May 1, 2025, has been approved.

Ms. Silva reviewed the minutes from last meeting. The draft form of the minutes was sent to the SAC email list beforehand for review as well.

School Updates from Principal, Mr. Rivera:

FAST Testing is officially over. The students scores have improved drastically from last year. There will be fewer regular classes and more accelerated classes for the upcoming school year.

25-25 Projected Budget for Tequesta Trace – presented by Principal Rivera: Mr. Rivera reviewed the projected budget for the 2025-2026 school year. He went over what the budget covers and how it's allocated. He reviewed how many sections of each course there will be compared to this year currently. He went over how many positions will be required in comparison to this year. We have some staff leaving (retiring, moving, etc) and those positions do not need to be replaced. We are reducing the amount of ESE aides by 1 as of now. Our numbers change daily for enrollment. The projected number of students are 1196 for the 2025-2026 school year. Elective classes will remain the same. SVE and VE program will remain for next year. The VE was successful for the most part this year. Sac guests asked what "VE means" and Mr. Rivera explained that it's an in between course where students who are special needs but take the state level tests will be with course certified and ESE certified teachers and will travel together and also take chosen elective courses. There will be one less ESE assistant for next year. We are projected to be an A school again next year. All information outlined in the PowerPoint presentation (uploaded into OSPA, Broward Central).

Review of School Accountability and School Recognition Funds at Tequesta Trace Middle School:

BTU Updates – Reggie Osorio, BTU Steward at TTMS:

Mr. Osorio is retiring and is handing the BTU Steward position to Varetta Cooper. 900 teachers are leaving Broward County this school year. 300 are leaving for discipline issues. 325 are leaving because they didn't complete their certifications from the state.

New Business at TTMS:

8th grade awards are tonight and are by invitation (5/29) and 2 tickets per honoree.
Yearbooks are being distributed. There are a few left for sale on the eStoe.
The author visit went well, and the students enjoyed it. Students got a chance for the author to sign their books, meet/greet, and take pictures with her.

6th and 7th grade students are registered for summer reading in Beanstack and the Broward County library and were informed of the rewards they are able to receive in a drawing. Last Friday, the 8th graders had their end of the year trip to Islands of Adventure, and it went well. TTMS has the most amazing students, so well behaved! The Track and Field County Championships were on May 13th and the boys finished in 5th place and the girls finished 4th place.
