



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



Voting day is November 20, 2024. Today we reviewed previous year ballot as an example. "None of the above" must be on the ballot. Today we will decide what will be on the ballot. Mrs. Kennedy stated that some schools use some of the funding to reward and celebrate students. PTO will fund school wide incentives to reward students for A school grade. We will keep the ballot from the previous school year. The additional changes are stated below.

Choice A: 100% of all monies will be used for a one-time bonuses. The monies will be divided among all 2023-2024 staff members on the pro-rated percentage of their employment.

Choices will be 1) Those employed at Park Springs Elementary (including campus monitors and food and services workers) 51% or greater, will receive 100% of one share. 2) Those employed at Park Springs Elementary (including campus monitors and food and services workers) 10 – 50%, will receive 50% of the share.

Voting on ballot choices results are 11 yes, 0 no. The staff will be notified of ballot choices prior to the voting date.


