**School Advisory Council/School Advisory Forum – Joint Meeting**

**Tuesday, November 4, 2025 at 1:55 p.m. in Media Center**

1. Call to Order/Welcome: Mrs. Cimaglia called to order at 2:07 (waiting to call forum-waiting to approve minutes at end of meeting)
2. Approve October's Minutes:
3. Principal's Update/Reports: kids excited with Apex and Halloween activities. Apex fundraiser, \$20,000 estimate for profit thus far, share with parents, PTO support with budget crunches, we are not title 1 so money taken away makes a difference.
  - a. SESIR: incident, indecent exposure, 2 so far for the year, battery against SBBC employee
  - b. Safety and Security: Halloween, campus used for parking and left dirty, Alhadeff came to campus and talked about cameras and security; Hannah will teach GRADE, working on schedule. Looking for SRO still. Crossing guard was hit by parent at a stop sign. Parents covering walker gate areas, we need to address so they aren't blocking the exit. Students are missing at dismissal due to parents not communicating with parents. Repaint the lines in parking lot, people coming in wrong way. Parents need to be aware of safety concerns. Chatting parents be aware of students
4. District Strategic Plan: District strategic plan-2022-2027, early literacy goals go from 52%-65% in 2025; science proficiency 48%-55%, but builds on 5<sup>th</sup> grade and needs to be at proficiency. Xello app goes over interests for students-in middle and high school more for work prep, district focus that we are at a SAFE school, equity for all students with resources, school supports, A's and B's, and C's throughout grades. Advertisements with ranking of schools, PSE achieved in top 20% over 3 years. ESE team met so that we are meeting the students needs. All students learning and becoming proficient. We need to continue with the achievement with all

populations in our school. We analyze data to make sure we are all learning. The bar raises the better the school scores.

5. FOCUS Parent Training: Goal reading/ELA by June K-2 70%-75% as measured by FAST STAR (reading training, district trainings, UFLI, ASD rooms using this program) building foundational skills to close gaps (SAF states that at another school they individualize screeners-Hanson states we do this now for K screeners to close skills gaps)

I ready diagnostic is used as PM data; strategies are as follows: 90 min of reading, daily interventions, K-5 grades, data chats, data comps every 5 weeks who is most fragile, how to close their gaps-how are we remediating and enriching, what are they doing in the reading block, ESE will start to share with Gen Ed to close gaps, 80% are in the gen ed setting, also we differentiate tasks and centers (ELL trainings, ELA trainings) that show how students should be mastering and or enriching students who need to be pushed forward. We are continuing to make sure all students are targeted for instruction.

Intermediate 3-5 grade 74%-78% we want to go higher with this goal using the same strategies mentioned, data and how can we monitor students for success, weekly PLC so that teams can plan and look at data, support from literacy coach, how are we targeting students with different activities, working together to close the gaps and engage students in their learning.

Lowest Quartile ELA, 56%-60%, most fragile students, retention students (3<sup>rd</sup>), lowest academic performance in 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> grade. We want to make sure everyone has 100% learning gains; we are working hard to meet the goals. We have added student conferences, they need to know where they are and where they are going in terms of the data. 5<sup>th</sup> graders know and can have a conversation about where they are going academically. We celebrate their successes and failures and encourage them to do better. We dropped a little with gifted high achieving, they have to maintain or go higher, Scott-the scale scores change per grade level. We are discussing where and what we are doing to move students. 66% Ela; LQ 58% Morell

Ms. Hanson, open enrollment is open now. We will take as many students as we can, so we don't change the staffing. New Kindergarten class coming soon-high achiever class-she's made phone calls to ask parents where they want to stay classroom wise. More information coming.

\*\*Mrs. Cimaglia: FOCUS Parent Portal: many resources in FOCUS for parents to use, many languages available-printables in office if needed for FOCUS resources, New World's coming up soon, the tabs show handbooks and other things that can be used for parents to use, 504 information can't access the forms and documents-parents aren't getting help with this-it's on a different app-Parents need to know how to use FOCUS, we will make a video to use and how to use the website. Only a few stragglers aren't on FOCUS, we are still following up with them so that they can sign up. There needs to be a scaffold for non-tech people or people who need extra help! One pager for parents is available but sometimes they don't read the information. \* add to parent presentation you will need to use FOCUS app this year to check up on student progress.

  - c. Accountability Funds: we pay Ms. Scott for summer training, K screeners an we use it for camps-the funds may be reduced or gone- we will use it for camps if this happens. The funds haven't hit yet, not yet, they take it out and put it back in, we are still waiting for the funds. The district hasn't made it aware of whether the funds are coming. We manage the money very well and sometimes some schools don't do this. \$9000-\$10000 around this budget-we are waiting for a real number so that we can budget. They bank on you not paying attention to the funds, but we maintain a tight budget. We need the money to come in, so we can vote it all out so we can use it. We are very responsible with our money. We will be voting in December if its there.

Parents need to understand what is available and what they can participate in.
