1. Call to Order/Welcome/Attendance: 2:10 call to order Ms. Cimaglia
2. Approved January's Minutes (quorum made) motion to approve made by Ms. Kelli Baltuskonis, seconded by Ms. Hanson
3. Principal's Update/Reports
 - a. Hiring Freeze district wide, just means positions not being filled, district staff is being used to fill in gaps, especially with schools being closed, one 5th grade teacher left, but we couldn't wait to get another teacher for the sake of student's learning, one teacher is on leave, one resignation without notice-subs have canceled and coverage is being realigned within our school, we are doing better than many schools and so we are trying to keep that up-facilities position open, we were able to apply for it (12:30-9), some candidates are being interviewed, aftercare not on hiring freeze, we are looking for two people-Ms. Hanson walking classroom to check on teachers and students, windows for reassignment is open and Ms. Hanson is looking at some details regarding this, new funding models being introduced, but nothing solid is given yet. Parent states that they may not say in an open forum budget plans, budget talks are always works and it isn't something new, we will work through the issues and concerns- we are doing FTE this week for attendance, schoolwide we are fiscally sound, if anything changes principal will communicate to parents/staff
 - b. Accountability Funds for student supplies-\$1242(school recognition funds for supplies only-needs quorum to vote) **-motion approved with 11 yes-all in favor to spend \$1242 for classroom supplies for our supply closet**

As of right now there is still \$13,136 in accountability as of February 3, 2026- That amount is already accounted for as we are in the process of using the monies approved at our last meeting for ELO camps, summer planning, art supplies that was previously voted on in January.

c. SESIR-no new incidents since December's SAC meeting.

d. Safety and Security-officer Gary going to BTA training-parent requested police presence traffic wise, tickets were given, some kids are coming to early and with weather can be a concern

Ms. Jimenez has a lot of background to the information needed for SAC and it will be a good opportunity; Ms. Cimaglia will be assisting with various tasks needed for SAC. **Amended 2/3/2026-all in favor-majority in favor-Jimenez will be holding both roles for now of teacher and SAC chair-11 people motion to approve-motion to change the committee-**

6. School Improvement Plan Monitoring/Stakeholder Feedback-

a. PM2 Data Presentation-ELA 56% proficiency LY; current 61%; MATH 44% to 48; SCIENCE 44% to 56% (5th grade only)- school counselor week-we have celebrated them-camp starting 2/19/26 for student learning-Guidance lessons for students with all the testing (a parent asks regrading this)- we have our day of service and love, gratitude and empathy, trusted adults around campus, counselors support students-reach out to child's teacher for any concerns

b. SIP Mid-Year Reflection- LQ for school improvement plan for ELA; we try to increase a little every year, 31% are making learning gains, many are ELL and ESE students, we are working strategically to help all students learn, our goal is to PM3 LQ are making learning gains. Ms. Hanson states that she uses a formula to gather a point percentage to set the goals for LQ, the gifted high achieving is also

hard to move and maintain those goals which are higher, there needs to be rigor for all students, for parents, kids should not be regressing and going back instead of growing forward on PM assessments, we are on track for LQ for the time being-
