**Welcome:** Meeting called to order at 2:30 PM by Michele Lozano.

**Approval of November Minutes:** Approved by Rebecca Hawronsky, Seconded by Amanda Richards.

**Florida A+ Recognition Funds:** Great job to Embassy Creek staff for being recognized as an A School again! The proposal of how to release funds to the school will be created by the SAC committee. Once proposals have been finalized with Proposal 3 stating- None of the Above it will be shared with all Embassy Creek Elementary Instructional, Non-Instructional, Cafeteria Staff, Campus Monitors via email. There is a three-day wait before the proposal is voted on by staff. Vote is scheduled for Thursday, December 18, 2025 in the Media Center from 2:00-3:00 pm. In the Media Center will also be BTU Steward, Administration, and SAC Chair.
