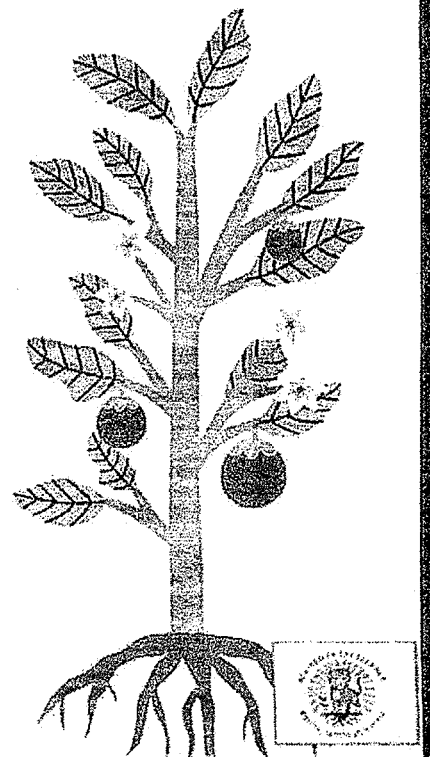

#### REPORTS

##### SAC Chair Report

The SAC Chair welcomed all parents and thanked them for attending the meeting.

Mrs. Haughton reviewed the minutes from the previous meeting.

Ms. Sands made a motion to accept the minutes; Mrs. Amos seconded the motion.

The minutes were approved.

##### Admin Report

- Parents were welcomed and encouraged to attend monthly School Advisory Council meetings to remain involved in their child's academic progress and school activities.
- Mrs. Butler reviewed the school safety plan and provided details about student supervision and expectations. She emphasized teaching students about body boundaries and reiterated that bullying is a zero-tolerance behavior. She encouraged parents to report incidents to

administrators. She also noted that the school has two campus monitors, and the district prioritizes school safety.

- Intermittent Assessments were explained. Teachers use assessment data to drive instruction and support continuous improvement for all students.
- A new iReady Initiative will launch soon. The iReady Math and Reading Competition will recognize students who complete 45 minutes per subject each week. Students access iReady through Clever. The platform provides tutorials and keeps students on a personalized learning path.
- Mrs. Butler discussed plans to open a school food pantry on campus where families can receive free food. Additional details will be provided soon.

### **Upcoming Events**

- Mrs. Amos reviewed information for upcoming assessments, which will begin with a school-wide pep rally. She encouraged parents to ensure students attend school daily and get adequate sleep before testing days.
- She also provided tentative dates for the PM2 FAST Assessments. Parents were informed about the school-wide incentive—the “Level Up Party”—and how students can qualify.
- Mrs. Amos highlighted the success of the school’s boys’ and girls’ basketball teams and shared the remaining season schedule. She expressed pride in all student-athletes.
- Mrs. Moncrieffe discussed the revised dates for upcoming SAC meetings, explaining that future meetings will be held in alignment with school events.
- She reviewed the School Finance Budget, reminding parents that next month the process for determining how A+ Money will be allocated will

be discussed with faculty and staff. She explained that although the allocation amount for this year has not yet been confirmed, the SAC Committee will vote on the final distribution proposal, which determines the percentage awarded to staff members.

#### Acaletics Report

Ms. Moncrieffe shared updates on the school's Math Program and the Acaletics Green Party Incentives.

Students who scored 30% proficiency in October earned a celebration party, with over 200 students participating.

Each month, the proficiency requirement increases by 10%; therefore, the goal for November is 40% proficiency.












