II. REPORTS.

SAC Chair Report:

The SAC Chair welcomed all parents to the meeting and thanked them for coming out. The minutes of the previous meeting were read. A motion to approve the minutes was made by Mrs. Amos and seconded by Mrs. Sands. The motion carried. Mrs. Moncrieffe discussed the dates for upcoming meetings and explained that SAC meetings will correspond with events being held at school. Mrs. Moncrieffe apologized for the absence of our newly appointed principal and introduced Mrs. Butler, the Assistant Principal, who provided updates on behalf of the principal.

Admin Report:

- Parents were welcomed and encouraged to attend the School Advisory Meeting each month to stay involved in their child's progress and school events.
- Mrs. Butler discussed our school safety plan and familiarized parents with details of the plan. She mentioned that we teach children body boundaries. Bullying is zero tolerance (no touching others). Parents should report to administrators if their child is experiencing this. We have two campus monitors. The school District recognizes the importance of safety. SRO Deputy Britz is housed here at Charles Drew and is always available and supportive.
- Intermittent Assessments were explained to parents. As educators, we want to make sure that our students are ready. We want our students to make continuous improvement; therefore, teachers use data to drive their instruction.
- The Character Parade will take place on October 31st.
- A new initiative is coming soon for iReady. The iReady Competition for math and reading will recognize those students from each grade level who have the most lessons pass each week. The winners will be announced every Monday and prizes awarded. Students go on i-Ready through Clever dashboard. iReady is a tutorial and keeps children on a learning path.
- Next month the process for determining how A+ money will be used will be explained to Faculty and Staff. SAC makes recommendations on how to use the money.

NEW BUSINESS

Upcoming School Events

- Harvest Drive - Plans for collecting non-perishable food items were discussed. Donation bins will be placed in designated areas.
- Harvest Parade- K-2nd Grade – The annual Storybook Parade is scheduled to take place October 31, 2025. This event is designated for students in kindergarten through second grade. Families are encouraged to provide candy donations to support the event.
- Harvest Dance - The Harvest Dance will serve as a fundraising event. Additional details will be shared with families through Parent Link and informational flyers.
