II. REPORTS.

SAC Chair Report:

The SAC Chair welcomed all parents to the new school year and thanked them for coming out. She explained the importance of this meeting, as we are selecting new SAC members and officers. The process for the selection via nominating committee was explained. SAC By-Laws were reviewed, and a copy given to all meeting participants. The floor was opened. Nominations were made and seconded for each position. The Chair asked for a motion to approve the nominations. Mrs. Moncrieffe approved the motion, and Mrs. Amos seconded the motion. A vote was taken individually for each nomination and all positions were unanimously approved.

Admin Report:

- Our school is happy to report that we moved up a letter grade and are now an A rated School!! Our goal for this year is to maintain the "A" rating.
- Parents were welcomed and encouraged to attend the School Advisory Meeting each month to stay involved in their child's progress and school events.
- Parents were also given information regarding the Open House that is taking place after the SAC meeting. They were also encouraged to sign up for individual conference with their child's teacher.

School Improvement Goals:

- By May 2025, 60% or more of students in Grades 3-5 will score at or above a level 3 on the ELA Florida Assessment for Student Thinking (FAST PM3)
- By May 2025, 60% or more of students in Grades K-2 will achieve proficiency on STAR Literacy PM3.
- By May 2025, 80% or more of students in Grades 3-5 will score at or above a level 3 on the Math Florida Assessment for Student Thinking (FAST PM3).
