<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Reports</li> <li>• North Area Advisory Council Highlights: Ms. Samuels</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Guy Barmoha, Director of Secondary Learning, presented to the group about district trends from PM1 data.</li> <li>• Currently 96% of the schools in Broward either maintained or increased their score from the previous year.</li> <li>• There were no D or F schools in Broward for the 2024-25 school year.</li> <li>• In 2024-25, 84% of schools earned an A or a B and the number of C schools reduced “tremendously”.</li> </ul>

- The district's goal for the 2025-26 school year is to have no C, D, or F schools.
  - The standard for how to earn an A is now higher and more challenging.
- The district has identified an anomaly in middle school math scores for students who move from 7<sup>th</sup> to 8<sup>th</sup> grade.
  - 8<sup>th</sup> grade PM data does NOT include 8<sup>th</sup> graders who are taking Algebra or Geometry—it only includes students enrolled in 8<sup>th</sup> grade pre-algebra.
  - This means that at the end of 7<sup>th</sup> grade, we see a good number of students proficient in math at PM3. These students then go into Algebra for 8<sup>th</sup> grade and are removed from the 8<sup>th</sup> grade PM1 data set. District 8<sup>th</sup> grade math PM1 data then shows a high number of students who test at levels 1 and 2 (not proficient).
- Elimination of Block Scheduling
  - The district was considering eliminating all block scheduling for the 2026-27 school year as a budget saving measure.
  - The School Board made the decision to maintain the current high school A/B block schedule with the personalization period. Middle schools will also be allowed to continue with their current schedules.
