



What is the School Advisory Council?

Each school has a School Advisory Council (SAC) comprised of:

- parents
- teachers
- community members
- school administrators
- non-instructional
- support staff
- other stakeholders

SAC meets monthly to establish school priorities, set annual objectives, and to monitor action steps for school improvement.

- SAC is mandated by State Statute 1001.452 and SBBC Policy 1403.
- All meetings are open to the public and aligned to Sunshine Law.
- A majority (more than half) of SAC members are not employed by Broward County Public Schools.
- SAC must be representative of the school's population and must include similar proportionate percentages from different ethnic groups.
