



What is the School Advisory Forum?

Every school has a School Advisory Forum (SAF) that fosters and promotes communication between its stakeholders, the school, and the Regional Advisory Council. They make recommendations, express concerns, and share interests to and from the North Area Advisory Council.

- SAF is mandated by SBBC Policy 1.3.**
- All meetings are open to the public and aligned to Sunshine Law.**
- Membership must be representative of the school community to include parents/guardians of students, students, and business/community partners**
- A Broward County School Board employee may not be the SAF Chair at the school where they are employed.**
- The Chair must be a parent/guardian of a student who is enrolled and attending the school.**
