- During Progress Monitoring 3 in May of 2025, 87% of our students scored at a level 1 in Math and 13% scored at a level 2
 - During Progress Monitoring 1 in September 2025, 95% of our students scored at a level 1 in Math and 5% scored at a level 2
- During Progress Monitoring 3 in May 2025, 71% of Cross Creek students scored at a level 1 in Reading, 22% scored at a a level 2, 2% scored at a level 3, and 5% scored at a level 4
 - During Progress Monitoring 1 in September 2025, 79% of our students scored at a level 1 in Reading, 18% scored at a level 2, and 3 % scored at a level 4
- Ms. Samuels asked when PM 2 testing will take place.
- Mrs. Stearn clarified that the window to assess our students for Progress Monitoring 2 opens immediately following the Thanksgiving break. We will be testing between December 2, 2025 and December 12, 2025 and will then have an additional week for makeups as needed before going out on Winter Break
- The top three priorities that Cross Creek is focusing on throughout the remainder of the school year are:



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- Improving ELA Reading Achievement- FAST ELA results from PM 3 (2024–2025) and PM 1 (2025–2026) show limited growth. Our priority is to provide interventions to students to improve ELA Reading assessment performance.
- Increase Math Proficiency- PM 3 (2024–2025) and PM 1 (2025–2026) FAST Math data indicate persistent gaps in computation accuracy and problem-solving fluency. Our priority is to provide intervention support to our students to attain proficiency.
- Strengthen Teacher Support- Teachers need consistent, targeted support and professional learning tied directly to student data. Our priority is to implement bi-weekly instructional coaching cycles focused on explicit instruction, model lessons using FAST data to address skill deficits, follow up with feedback and reflection sessions.
- Mr. Butler asked what things are being put in place to address the minimal growth between PM3 and PM1
- Mrs. Stearn explained some of the actions in place to address the school’s priorities including:
 - Weekly grade-level meetings to discuss student progress



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- Quarterly PLCs using FAST dashboards to analyze trends
- Expanding Tier 2 and Tier 3 interventions in both ELA and Math with push-in and pull-out by ESE support staff
- Conducting classroom walkthroughs focused on explicit instruction and evidence-based ESE strategies
- Embedding formative assessments into instruction weekly to track growth and adjust instruction as needed
- Conducting quarterly student and teacher data chats to review performance and set goals
- Analyzing behavior and attendance data alongside academic tracking to address barriers to learning
- ESE Data Dive with district ESE staff took place on November 3, 2025. District staff and Cross Creek academic team members met to map out some plans for addressing the Tier 2 and 3 academic needs of our student population. Curriculum/materials were allocated to Cross Creek by both the ESE Department (Moving With Math) by Director Sheib and the North Regional Superintendent's Office (Reading Materials) by Director Weiss-Schnur
