Call to Order

Dr. Carey called the Student Advisory Council meeting to order at **8:30 AM**.

Welcome

The meeting began with a welcome to all members, parents, staff, and community partners in attendance.

Approval of Agenda

The agenda for the March 2026 meeting was presented. Ms. Ward moved to accept the agenda as printed. Ms. Martinez seconded the motion. **Motion carried.**

Approval of January 2026 Minutes (No meeting in February)

The minutes from the January 2026 meeting were reviewed and Ms. Lockhart moved to accept the minutes as printed. Mr. Smith seconded the motion. **Motion carried.**

Principal Updates

Ms. Flowers shared positive academic updates highlighting a strong start to Quarter 3.

She encouraged academic growth updates across grade levels. Student performance data indicates steady progress in reading, mathematics, and core content areas, supported by targeted, standards-aligned instruction.

- Teachers are utilizing formative assessments and benchmark data to guide instructional decisions, provide timely interventions, and support small-group learning. Increased student engagement, consistent attendance, and focused instructional strategies have contributed to improved outcomes.
- Ongoing academic support and progress monitoring remain a priority to ensure continued growth throughout the remainder of 2025-2026 school year.

Key points included:

- **Support Programs:** Academic support, including double-down, enrichment opportunities, and targeted interventions, are contributing to improved student outcomes.
- **Celebrations of Success:** The school continues to recognize student achievement, academic improvement, and teacher collaboration as key drivers of Quarter 3 success. Honor Roll celebrations will be held after spring break.
- **Accountability Funds:** An overview of the use and allocation of accountability funds was shared. Ms. Flowers proposed the following recommendation:

\$4,455.31 (available)

\$2600.00 for custodial supplies

\$1855.31 for student recognition and incentives (honor roll, medallion certificates, Be Out Day 2026).

- **School Recognition Dollars:**

6,932.00 (available)

\$2900.00 ELO camp for instructional and non-instructional; staff

\$4032.00 for teacher and staff appreciation include lunch, gift shirts, initiatives and awards.

The recommendations were discussed in length with the body. Ms. Ward moved to accept the two monetary recommendations to uplift the school community for 2025-2026 school year. Ms. Martinez seconded the motion. **Motion carried**

- **BTA/SESIR:** Updates related to behavior tracking and school safety reporting were discussed.

BTU-related information and updates relevant to staff and families were shared about teacher raises.

Title I Binder Updates (2025–2026)

Updates to the Title I Binder for the 2025–2026 school year were reviewed, including required documentation and family access. The documents are being submitted for compliance by mid- March deadline.

She encouraged the body that their voice matters, and their feedback helps Thurgood Marshall Elementary School better serve our students and families. She also thanked them for their continued support and partnership.
