Meeting Minutes

Minutes for January, February and April were approved with no changes on a motion by Vanessa and seconded by Kristi.

New Members- None at this time

Assistant Principal's Report and SESIR report- No new SESIR incidents were reported

School Accountability Funds- Current Balance: \$7580

Projected 2026-2027 balance will be less once the rest of ELO salaries are taken. Currently funds began at approximately \$11,000, are currently about \$7,500, and are expected to end around \$6,000. These are the only funds used to support the math and ELO camps.

SIP Monitoring Feedback/ Principal's Report:

The principal reported that the budget will be finalized on the 12th and is currently a projection. The school budget does not fluctuate as much because the school consistently maintains a long waitlist, and projections remain strong for the next 10 years.

Positions may be cut, but not people.

There are no changes in class sections from this year. The school will keep all four specials, although only three are funded through the regular budget and the fourth will continue to be supported through other funding sources.

The Media Specialist position has been approved and will not be part of the specials rotation; students will still attend weekly, or biweekly for older students depending on scheduling.

Instructional support will remain the same.

School recognition funds for A schools are received each year in November.

New Business:

ELO camps have just finished.

Awards were recognized for volunteer hours over 200.

Suggestion for beginning of next year: review the different tests and programs and clarify what each is used for, such as STAR versus FAST.

Kristi L. K-2 testing has been completed and results look strong, with just under 90% proficiency. Testing for grades 3-5 is still in progress.
