**VIII. School Improvement Plan Monitoring**

- Mr. Gielar presented our 2025-2026 school goals for Mathematics and Reading.
  - o By May 2026, students will increase overall proficiency/achievement from 73% to 76% by scoring Levels 3, 4, or 5 on the End-of-Year Math assessments including FAST 6-8, Algebra EOC, and Geometry EOC.
  - o By May of 2026, students will increase overall proficiency/achievement in grades 6-8 in ELA from 72% to 76%.
- Mr. T presented the PM1 F.A.S.T. data

- ELA Proficiency
  - 6<sup>th</sup>- 64%      7<sup>th</sup>: 59%      8<sup>th</sup>: 53%
- MATH Proficiency
  - 6<sup>th</sup>: 41%      7<sup>th</sup>: 36%      8<sup>th</sup>: 3%

- Mr. Campuzano presented the school-wide behavior plan. He discussed the top 5 referral occurrences: unruly behavior, mistreatment of peers, out of area, disruptive play, and insubordination. The strategies implemented this year (which have already had an effect) are support for students, scheduling to avoid conflict, Mustang reward tickets, and security.
- 7 weeks in- 9 total referrals

**IX. Principal's Report**

- There will be a parent link received on Monday, September 29<sup>th</sup>, regarding the redesigning schools initiative.
- Instructional Review: We held our first instructional review, and it went very well. The visiting personnel loved walking through the classrooms. We were told to keep doing what we are doing. STMS is slated to hold another IR in January.

**X. SAF Chair Report**

- Mr. T presented on behalf of SAF. The meeting mostly discussed Title 1 funds, which do not directly affect STMS.
- School nurses are not mandatory, but instead, they travel with students who have diabetes. Therefore, some schools may not have a full-time nurse on campus, but STMS does.
- SVE Classrooms: The policy states that classrooms may be recorded; however, if one parent objects, it overrides the camera policy.
