Sawgrass Springs Middle: SAC-SAF Minutes for April 2, 2026

8:06 – Call to order by Mrs. Stull-Milordis

- **8:06 – Quorum met, Approval of 3/5/26 SAC minutes:** Kupka made the motion to approve, Fink seconded the motion, all voted in favor.
- **8:07 Principal Report, Mrs. Wessinger –**
 - 22 SESSER events
 - Condolences for the loss of Coral Springs Vice Mayor. Worked as an advocate for SSMS.
 - Accountability funds balance given. \$8,312 balance, minus \$4,000 for ELO, calculators for either \$1758 or \$1,983, and \$571 for poster printer. Wessinger reported that SAC should not control the money. Questions raised about purpose of SAC accountability funds. Future funds will only be from Class Wallet leftover funds. SAC still needs to oversee the SIP plan.
 - Customer survey update. 20% of parents needed, Principal encouraged parents to fill out the survey.
 - Projection enrollment, 835 for 2026-2027 school year. The school believes that based on district formula, our projection is different at 872 students. School funds will be prorated as needed by the district after future FTE counts
- **8:21 BTU Update, Dr. Pierre -** Looking for 60% of teachers to join the union. District needs 60% of teachers to join to keep union certified. SSMS met goal for 5 of our staff to join, BTU waiting for numbers from other schools.
- **8:23, PTO Update, Ms. Greenhauff:** \$3,050 raised from Color Run. Louie G's and Wings Plus giveback, made \$35 from Louie G's, waiting for results from Wings Plus. Five Guys hasn't sent payment yet. April 16, Principals Honor Roll, VIP Red Carpet theme for the event. Haggen Daz giveback raised \$271. Bus driver appreciation, PTO will provide goodies for bus drivers. Parent (insurance business) donated \$500 for the school, to general funds. PTO sponsored track uniform for one their students who is a special needs student who did not have a proper uniform.
- **8:28, SAF Update, Ms. Leath:** update as well on direction regarding accountability funds, directive is to spend the money. Comments and suggestions were solicited by Ms. Leath, to bring to district SAF meeting in April.
- **8:32, Nature Center, Community partner update, Ms. Reccasina:** registering students and volunteers/CITs for summer camp. April 25th, SSMS will have booth at their community event, Earth Fest.

- **8:35, New Business, Ms. Kim Smith:** looking for \$570 to get certified by the Coral Springs Regional Institute of Public Safety to get their K-12, CPR AED Training for students. Mrs. McMahon made the motion, Mr. D seconded the motion. All members voted in favor. Funding request granted.
- **8:38, NJHS Update, Ms. Reidmeyer:** Beach cleanup Saturday April 11, 9 AM – 12 PM, on Deerfield Beach. Students will work together to collect trash; Deerfield will provide tools and collect the trash from the cleanup. Meetup will be next to fire station # 75. NJHS would like to host a FAST pep rally ahead of 2026 PM 3.
- **8:40, CTACE Update, Mr. Desruisseaux:** Monthly meeting in March: CAPE money normally comes in December. Still waiting for about \$40,000. \$10.5 Million desktop computer refresh grant planned for next school year. SSMS as one of the top CAPE earners, SSMS will be close to the top of the list to get one of those refreshes.
- **8:43, Dr. Pierre, debate team update:** 5 students going to national competition in Virginia. Flamingo Tours was too expensive, so students will go with their parents independently.
- **8:44, Yearbook Update, Ms. Stull-Milordis:** Yearbook ice cream party sponsored by PTO, yearbook has been submitted for printing.
- **8:45, Motion to Adjourn, Ms. Leath:** Ms. Leath motion to adjourn, Ms. Greenhauff seconded the motion, all in favor.
