Call to order: A meeting of the Eagle Ridge Elementary School Advisory Council was held in the media center on January 7th 2026. Katheryn de Iage, called the meeting to order at 2:35. Laura Welser is the recording secretary for this meeting.

Minutes: The December 2025 minutes: motion to approve Nicole Diamas, 2nd Johanna Cardoso. The December 2025 minutes were approved unanimously.

Budget: School Recognition Funds \$5,197 School Accountability Funds \$3,322.67

- Presentation by Mrs. Piccone's dual language class. Students presented information about a day in the life of a dual language student.
- **New Business:**
 - **ELO Camp:** Proposal requesting \$7,000 to fund an extended learning opportunity camp (ELO) for math tutoring after school. The proposal is for 2 4th grade and 2 5th grade groups, and 1 coordinator. The camp will run 8 weeks twice a week from 2-3pm. The free tutoring will be provided to students identified through data as having significant instructional needs.
 - Mrs. Figas made a motion to approve the proposal for the funds. Mrs. Diamas made a 2nd motion. The floor opened to discussion, Mrs. Sierra explained that FAST scores were lower in math for PM2, we did take it 4 weeks earlier than last year. There are a lot of standards coming up that need to be covered before the end of the year, and we want to support students the best that we can. We just need the extra time to help support this targeted group of students.
 - We will also be starting morning groups that will start at 7:30 for students to do iReady. Mrs. Glancy will be opening the media center to students wanting to come and work on their iReady pathways in math each week.
 - Mrs. Diamas made a motion to vote for approval, Mrs. Duquette 2nd the motion, the proposal passed unanimously.
 - A+ money update
 - Staff voted on December 5th, 2025.
 - Option A 57% of votes, Option B 39% of votes, Option C 4%.
 - Option A won with 57% of votes
 - All paperwork has been submitted and we are just waiting now for the payout.








- Principal's updates:
 - Kindergarten round up am session tomorrow an evening event in February.
 - Reassignments 200 seats are open with most going to kindergarten students. With other spread among other grade levels.
 - Kindergarten screenings in the last week of July
 - Dual Language information night was held in December we will hold another one in July before school starts.
 - Testing is coming up next week with iReady reading and then math the next week. iReady gives us more detailed information, it breaks down the students into instructional groups and places students on updated instructional pathways on their individualized levels. iReady is split up over 2 days. We use it to plan for adjustments to curriculum and maximize meeting students' needs.
 - Science mid-year assessments will take place at the end of the month as well.
 - We started Leader in Me school wide yesterday. As adults we started our journey, but we are now implementing it with students. We started yesterday with the first habit yesterday beginning with being proactive. We are looking to bring out genius in all students and build their leadership skills. The plan is to teach each habit to the students before the year is over.
- **School Environmental Safety Incident Reporting (SESSIR):** Mrs. Glancy reported that there were 0 incidents.



Next meeting: Monday February 2nd, at 2:30 PM in the media center.
