**Call to order:** A meeting of the Eagle Ridge Elementary School Advisory Council was held in the staff training room on February 2, 2026. Katheryn delage, called the meeting to order at 2:36 PM . Laura Welser is the recording secretary for this meeting.

**Minutes:** The January 2025 minutes: motion to approve Nicole Diamas, 2<sup>nd</sup> Denise Tobar. January 2025 minutes were approved unanimously.

**Budget:** School Recognition Funds: \$5,197 School Accountability Funds \$3,322.67

- FAST Data updates for PM2: 64% 3<sup>rd</sup> graders proficient or higher, 50% of students in 3<sup>rd</sup> are showing learning gains and 50% of lowest quartile are showing learning gains. 63% of students are proficient, 46% are showing learning gains and 25% of the lowest quartile in 4<sup>th</sup> are showing learning gains. 68% of 5<sup>th</sup> graders are proficient, 56% of them are showing learning gains and 51% of the lowest quartile are showing learning gains.
- We are really looking to focus on our 4<sup>th</sup> graders and support them, when looking at data and going through data chats and looking kid by kids we see a need to focus more on supporting our 4<sup>th</sup> graders.
- We are on track to meet our goals and higher that we were at this point last year.
- Science: 37% of 3<sup>rd</sup> graders are showing proficiency, 14% of 4<sup>th</sup> graders are showing proficiency, 41% of 5<sup>th</sup> graders are showing proficiency at this point in the year based on mid-year assessments.
- **Principal Sierra's updates**
  - iReady data updates: students just finished iReady testing, we are looking at this data to also see where we are, and how students are doing. It recalibrates where the students are and makes sure that their instructional pathway is correct. We use the data to drive our crunch time plan.
  - We are focusing on 4<sup>th</sup> grade math. We have an ELO camp starting February 18<sup>th</sup>, we have invited 30-40 students to participate in math camp. Reviewing standards for the first half of the year and build for the end of the year. We reshuffled our Eagle Shuffle for the 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter, and we added 2- 4<sup>th</sup> grade math groups. Students were identified and leveled so they can receive targeted support and interventions. iReady camp with Mrs. Glancy in the morning for math 70 students were invited to attend on Tuesday and Thursdays only about 20 students are coming so far.
  - iReady party coming up if students met halfway to their typical growth, (a half a years growth) they have been invited to a popsicle (k-2) ice cream (3-5) party.


- **School Environment Safety Incident Reporting:** Mrs. Glancy: We did have 1 SESSIR incident for January.
- **Discipline Data-** October 14-December 19<sup>th</sup>: 648 students: 19 referrals (2-5 referrals) 97% effective with school wide behavior plan, 3% of our students have received 2-5 referrals. No students received more than 5. Unruly disruptive behavior in grades 3-5 is our highest area of concern. Referral totals: August 3, September 3, October 15, November 3 and December 13. 17 classroom referrals, 5 on the athletic fields, 4 in the cafeteria and 4 in the hallways for a total of 13. 57% of our referrals come from the classroom. Referrals by grade level 0-Kindergarten, 5 referrals/ 4 students -1<sup>st</sup> grade, 8 referrals/5students in 2<sup>nd</sup> grade, 9 referrals/3 students in 3<sup>rd</sup> grade,4 referrals/4 students in 4<sup>th</sup> grade, 4 referrals/3 students in 5<sup>th</sup> grade.
- A+ money update:
  - Everyone has received their A+ money





