

 - Budget Projections:**
 - Based on actual number of students who show up during FTE in October
 - 2026-2027 enrollment projections: Pk 24, K-3: 239.79, 4-5: 165.06, ELL 38.44, ESE 251 49.6, ESE 252: 33.05, ESE 253:65.56, ESE 254: 5.66, ESE 255: 0, ESE 261: 6.8 (gifted) total: 604.02 : The target is 601 if we drop below that we will have to lose positions.
 - Instructional 25 teacher 1.1 million\$
 - Support \$642,996
 - Educational Enrichment: \$1,981,627

- **School Environmental Safety Incident Reporting (SESIR) Mrs. Glancy**
