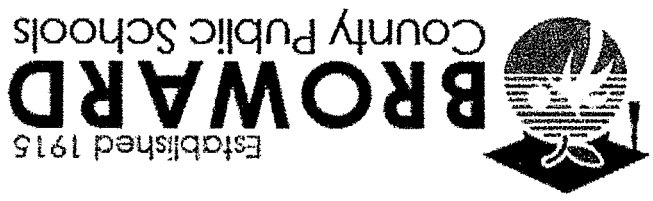

Call to order: A meeting of the Eagle Ridge Elementary School Advisory Council was held in the media center on September 15, 2025. Kathryn delage, called the meeting to order at 2:35. Laura Welsler is the recording secretary for this meeting.

Minutes: The May minutes: motion to approve Loreta Martinez, 2nd Laura Welsler. There was a change of spelling made to a parent's name in attendance at the meeting in August. Motion to approve by Anne Miller, 2nd Laura Welsler. The August 2025, and May 2025 minutes were approved.

Budget: School Improvement Funds: \$0 School Accountability Funds \$11

▪ New Business:

○ School Improvement Goals Plan

- **Goal 1:** Eagle Ridge will increase the percentage of students scoring proficient or higher on the 5th Grade Florida Statewide Science Assessment from 68% to 71% by May 2026. To monitor progress toward the fifth-grade science proficiency goal, Eagle Ridge will implement a streamlined, multi-layered strategy. Teachers will use Progress Learning Micro Assessments and the Middle-of-the-Year Science Assessment to track student understanding of key standards throughout the year. These tools will help identify instructional gaps and guide timely adjustments to instruction. Additionally, the leadership team and teachers will meet quarterly to review student data and collaboratively develop targeted instructional approaches based on evolving student needs.

- **Goal 2:** By May 2026, Eagle Ridge will increase overall ELA proficiency in grades 3-5 from 72% to 75% and for grades K-2 from 67% to 70% as measured by the FAST PM3 assessment. To ensure progress toward this goal, Eagle Ridge is prioritizing the strengthening of Tier 1 instruction through ongoing professional learning. Teachers are receiving targeted training in small group instruction and data-driven decision-making to enhance core reading instruction. Progress will be monitored using FAST PM1 and PM2 assessments, and student data will be triangulated with benchmark and iReady results to identify instructional needs. Teachers and administrators will collaborate in quarterly growth chats to reflect on student progress, adjust instructional strategies, and engage families in supporting learning at home.

- **Goal 3:** By May 2025, the percentage of 4th and 5th graders in the lowest quartile achieving learning gains in ELA will increase from 40% to 50% as evidenced by the FAST ELA PM 3. To monitor progress toward this goal teachers and administration will use the FAST assessment PM1 and PM 2 and analyze the data to identify areas of need. Teachers and administrators will collaborate in quarterly growth chats to reflect on student progress, adjust instructional strategies, and engage families in supporting learning at home.

▪ **Principals Welcome and Updates:**

- **Introduction of Mrs. Chery:** new guidance counselor who started last week. She comes to us from Floranada Elementary School.
- **Teacher of the Year:** Mrs. Hayes
- **Employee of the Year:** Monica Gonzalez ESOL Para
- **Clubs** started there are still spaces available in some clubs reach out to Happy Campers or Joy Deco if interested.
- **Apex fundraiser** was delayed this week due to weather. We will have our obstacle course on Wednesday for the kids. We are planning to use the funds to purchase a digital marquee, ink for the teacher printers, and umbrellas for the common areas. As of Friday, we have raised about \$30,000 but the window is still open to raise money.
- **FTE money** will come in October at about \$5 per student we will need to vote on how we want to spend the money as a committee.
- **School Painting:** We are on the district list to be painted in 2027.
- **School Environmental Safety Incident Reporting (SESIR) Mrs. Glancy**
 - We have had 0 SESSIR incidents since our last meeting.

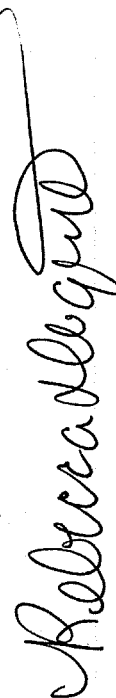
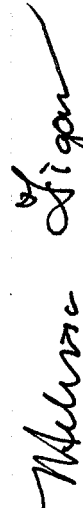
