1. **CALL TO ORDER / INTRODUCTIONS -**  
The meeting was called to order at 2:21.
  
2. **REVIEW / APPROVAL OF PREVIOUS MEETING'S MINUTES -** The minutes were sent via email to all members for their review. There were no revisions needed, the minutes from the previous meeting were approved.
  
2. **SCHOOL ENVIRONMENTAL SAFETY INCIDENT REPORTING (SESIR)**  
There were no SESIR incidents to report.
  
3. **ACCOUNTABILITY FUNDS**  
There are \$2,811.09 in accountability funds. During a previous meeting a vote was passed to utilize no more than \$10,000 to pay teachers for academic camps. Although there is a balance these funds are being used to pay teachers, just have not hit the budget yet.
  
4. **SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT PLAN MONITORING AND STAKEHOLDER FEEDBACK (SIP)**  
We are working towards the SIP, and our goals are currently aligned. We had a faculty meeting this week as a middle of the year state of affairs update. There is a lot of talk in the district regarding the budget cuts and freezes. We will wait to see how that impacts our school.  
Our students are doing well based on the available data from PM2. Data was shared from all grade levels comparing the data from PM1 to PM2 (attached). Overall student scores are improving. We are doing well as far as proficiency, need to focus on learning gains. Our 3<sup>rd</sup> grade math scores are currently in first place in the district. We are providing support in classrooms.

We will be starting a Science Kahoot game in the evenings from 7pm-8pm for 5<sup>th</sup> grade students. We are offering an incentive - field trip to i-Fly to get students to participate.




