


1. **CALL TO ORDER / INTRODUCTIONS** - The meeting was called to order at 2:25PM. Out of 24 SAC members, there were 15 present; quorum has been met for voting.
2. **REVIEW / APPROVAL OF PREVIOUS MEETING'S MINUTES** - The minutes were sent via email to all members for their review. There were no revisions needed, the minutes from the previous meeting were approved.
3. **SCHOOL ENVIRONMENTAL SAFETY INCIDENT REPORTING (SESIR)** - There were no SESIR incidents to report.
4. **ACCOUNTABILITY FUNDS \$2,811.09** - During a previous meeting approval was obtained by a vote to utilize no more than \$10,000 to pay teachers for academic camps. Math Academic Camp will begin on Monday, January 12th and end on February 25th. Two teachers will be teaching the camp, which will be focused on Math. Students were chosen based on PM2 data, approximately 30 students were invited to attend. The curriculum will be narrowed down by standards so that it is aligned with student performance. There will be twelve sessions on Mondays & Wednesday from 2:15 to 3:15pm.
5. **SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT PLAN MONITORING AND STAKEHOLDER FEEDBACK (SIP)**
 - A. **WAITING FOR PM2 DATA FOR PROGRESS MONITORING** - PM 2 data is now available, our ELA data is spectacular. Looks like we are leaning towards number one in the district and 2nd place in Math.
 - B. **DATA CHATS WILL BE TAKING PLACE WITH TEACHERS**
6. **PRESENTATIONS**
 - A. **PRINCIPAL UPDATE** - We have added a new 5th grade elective, an A.R. elective. We have found that many of our 5th grade students are not reading so we added the A.R. elective for 5th grade students. To be exempt from this elective student must have at least 50,000 words read. We also have a new Math elective, taught by admin and support for 5th grade students that are having difficulty in Math. This is held during 5th grade elective time in the Science lab.
 - B. **EPE SPOTLIGHT (MEDIA)** - Tabled for the next meeting.

7. NEW BUSINESS

A. **A+ RECOGNITION FUNDS** - Due to some recent changes that we were unaware of, we must re-do the A+ voting process. The sample ballot that was previously approved was reviewed by the committee. The ballot presented is as follows:

Proposal A - Equal distribution - Funds are distributed equally to all eligible employees, Instructional and Non-Instructional.

Proposal B - 80/20 split - Funds are distributed 80% to instructional staff and 20% to non-instructional employees.

Proposal C - None of the above

To be eligible:

- Instructional employees are teachers, guidance counselors, ESE support team and administration.
- Non-Instructional are office staff, custodial, paraprofessionals, cafeteria staff and campus monitors.
- The employee had to be present for at least 99 school days (where students are present) during the 2024-2025 school year.
- Part time employees will receive 50% of the amount.
- Employees shared with other schools will receive 50% of the amount.

A motion was made by Hania Majzoub to accept the above proposal and seconded by Erin Freeman. The above proposals were voted on; all the members below were present and voted "yes" to the above proposal:






