- 1. CALL TO ORDER / INTRODUCTIONS** - The meeting was called to order at 2:20pm.
- 2. REVIEW / APPROVAL OF PREVIOUS MEETING'S MINUTES** - The minutes from the February meeting were emailed to the committee members for review. No revisions to the minutes. A motion to approve the minutes was made by Mrs. Turner and seconded Mrs. Majzoub, minutes accepted.
- 3. SCHOOL ENVIRONMENTAL SAFETY INCIDENT REPORTING (SESIR)** - Nothing to report.
- 4. ACCOUNTABILITY FUNDS - \$ 1,550.70**
The accountability funds have been voted on and approved to be used for afterschool academic camps which are currently ongoing.
- 5. SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT PLAN MONITORING AND STAKEHOLDER FEEDBACK (SIP)** - Customer survey sent out, important to have as many to take the survey as possible.
- 6. PRESENTATIONS** - Mrs. Costantino for Art & Mr. Wozniak for Debate Club
Mrs. Costantino - There are many art shows coming up:
February Youth Art Month - Art pieces go to KC Wright - where we send two exceptional pieces of student art for a ceremony on March 12th. We had two students that did not attend due to a field trip.
Food & Nutrition poster content - We have six students that submitted pieces and are currently displayed at District now -. An award ceremony is coming up in April.
Winterfest Parade Art parade - students submit on their own. The pieces are displayed at the Museum of Science & Discovery. The ceremony will be on April 11th.
Student Artist Showcase - This event takes place every year, all schools in Weston are encouraged to participate. We send ten pieces to the Weston Regional Community Center there is an online exhibit also. Award ceremony will be on May 7th.
Autism Awareness & Accept - participating with posters hung up around the school.
5th grade is working on a tile mural. Will be hung in 5th grade hallway for 30-year celebration.

Mr. Wozniak - Autism awareness Q & A drop box - for students to ask questions about autism.
Finished debate competition season - Southeast region tournament; 650 students participating. We had more success this year with nine medal winners from twenty-two competing students - our kids are getting it. Saturday, there is a middle school style competition event that consists of 5 rounds of over 6 hours the winner takes home a trophy. This event is the culmination of the debate season. Trying to come up with a day and time where we can show our debate work to the students and staff at our school.

7. NEW BUSINESS

Last quarter we began 4th grade reading & math camps where we targeted "bubble" students. We don't have much money to spend, but it dictates the number of kids that can attend. Another group targeted are students than last year scored 4 & 5 last year but are not on target this year. This goes against our scores for learning gains so we would not get those points. If students don't score the same or better as in previous year, we do not get those points. We added a STEM class for low performing students for math & science, we are having small groups in the morning with these students. Mrs. Bass, one of our retired veteran teachers, is coming in as a volunteer to work with students. In the afternoon, admin is working with students that do not know how to do long division, they are missing important steps, and we are working on this.

We are heading into budget season, where we have membership projections for next year. Enrollment is declining in the district. Our school is feeling it as well, we are currently projected at 1019 students for the 26/27 school year. A decrease in projected enrollment decreases the budget which impacts on salaries and the number of teachers we will have for next year. We do have two retiring teachers and hopefully the exiting teachers offset the number of positions that we may have to delimit.

We are hoping to get more students enrolled. We do have several reassignments so hopefully we get enough. We received seventy school choice awarded, 30 for kindergarten but have not actually enrolled yet.

The 25/26 Customer Survey is ongoing and important, please complete.

Mrs. Lomonaco asked if we reach out to families that were reassigned in an effort to have them register; Mrs. Joanna calls these families to follow up.






