School Advisory Committee (SAC) Minutes
11/18/2025 at 2:30 PM

1. A meeting of the Silver Palms Elementary School Advisory Committee was held in the media center on November 18, 2025, Monica Castellanos (chair) called the meeting to order at 2:37 pm and Polett Williams recorded the meeting minutes.
2. In attendance: Irina Shearer, Natalie Allen, Monica Castellanos, Crystal Clark, Tatiana Colon, Tameka McField, Lizette Lemieux, Dina Linero, Jannette Peralta, Alesia Tinner, and Polett Williams. Quorum was established.
3. Introduction
4. Approval of the November agenda motioned by Tatiana Colon and seconded by Alesia Tinner.
5. Approval of October 29, 2025, minutes motioned by Alesia Tinner and seconded by Natalie Allen. A change of the next meeting date to today, November 18, 2025, rather than November 19th will be reflected.
6. Principal report:
 - a. Silver Palms Elementary's Trunk or Treat was a big success.
 - b. Math Family Night was also a big success, thank you to Mathnesium.
 - c. Kindergarten feast will be this Thursday, November 20th.
 - d. Chorus is preparing for their Holiday performance on December 18th.
 - e. PTA Turkey Trot will be this Friday, November 21st.
 - f. PTA is preparing for the Jingle Jog in December.
 - g. iReady rewards were distributed this week, thank you to PTA for all the donations.
 - h. Progress Monitoring (PM) 2 begins on December 2nd and ends on December 15th.
 - i. IReady Diagnostic 2 will begin in January.
7. New Business:
 - a. Accountability funds \$0. District is working on budget and will distribute money one that is complete.
 - b. Mrs. Schriedell (Assistant principal) and Ms. Allen (media clerk) gave a Presentation of Library Media Collection Development Plan. They discussed the proposed use of funds and timeline.
 - c. Mrs. Tinner moved to approve the proposal for Library Media Collection Development plan, and Ms. Linero seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously via roll call.
 - d. No School Environmental Safety Incident Reporting (SESIR) incidents to report
