School Advisory Committee (SAC) Minutes
01/28/2026 at 2:30 PM

1. A meeting of the Silver Palms Elementary School Advisory Committee was held in the media center on January 28, 2026, Monica Castellanos (chair) called the meeting to order at 2:33 pm and Polett Williams recorded the meeting minutes.
2. In attendance: Shannon Schreidell, Natalie Allen, Monica Castellanos, Tatiana Colon, Lizette Lemieux, Dina Linero, and Polett Williams. Quorum was not established.
3. Approval of January 28, 2026, agenda motioned by Tatiana Colon and seconded by Amy Bender.
4. Approval of November 29, 2025, minutes motioned by Tatiana Colon and seconded by Lizette Lemieux.
5. Principal report:
 - a. The School-Wide Positive Behavior Plan (SWPBP) is effectively minimizing behavioral misconduct and discipline referrals.
 - b. The boundary change was approved. Silver Palms Elementary is now part of the West Broward Zone, and students will transition to Silver Trails Middle School and West Broward High School upon promotion.
 - c. Multiple school tours are being conducted, particularly for parents of Panther Run students who are now included within the school's boundaries.
 - d. The NED Show was a great success and supports the promotion of positive behaviors aligned with the SWPBP.
6. New Business:
 - a. Accountability Funds: The current balance is \$0. Funds were released to support the Coaching in Academics (CIA) after-school extended learning opportunity camp.
 - b. School Environmental Safety Incident Reporting (SESIR): There were no incidents to report.
 - c. School Improvement Plan (SIP): Goals are on track toward end-of-year targets.
 - **English Language Arts (ELA):**
 - Grades K–2: 57% proficiency (71% goal)
 - Grades 3–5: 61% proficiency (75% goal)
 - **Mathematics:**
 - Grades K–2: 53% proficiency (75% goal)
 - Grades 3–5: 48% proficiency (78% goal)
 - d. CIA Camp is currently in session, serving one class each in third, fourth, and fifth grades for both reading and mathematics. Students were selected based on criteria agreed upon by teachers and the leadership team, with consideration given to the camp's short duration to maximize academic gains.
