#### V. School Improvement Plan

As of 4/21, 56% of **students** have completed the survey, exceeding the target of 40%.

We have not yet met our participation targets for **Parents and staff**: 16% of parents have completed the survey with a target of 20%.

35% of staff have completed the survey with a target of 60%.

Parents, school staff, and students are encouraged to participate using the links and QR codes included in the stakeholder flyers.

#### VI. Schoolwide Positive Behavior Plan – SPBP

Recognizing and rewarding positive behaviors

Building a safe and supportive school culture

89 referrals 53 from classrooms, 36 from common areas

Top 3 common areas: bus, cafe, playground

Top 5 behavior incidents: unruly disruptive behavior, disruptive/unruly play, disobedience/insubordination, bus-all levels, and larceny/theft minor

Schoolwide expectations discussed

Goals in the new plan: reduce classroom referrals, focus on unruly/disruptive behavior, increase adherence to schoolwide expectations, utilize incentive programs, and use flowchart for consistency to determine classroom managed behavior.

Intervention plan- Curriculum Be the 1: Bullying prevention, resiliency lessons, reward positive behavior, and token system.
