Dr. Reyes provided the Principal's Report, highlighting that baseline testing with iReady and FAST is complete, and teachers are using this data to guide instruction and targeted interventions. Proficiency from PM1 has improved compared to last year, with a focus on growth over perfection, aiming for each student to show a year's worth of progress. While kindergarten EL proficiency has increased, Grade 2 reading proficiency has declined, with 44% of students currently proficient in reading according to iReady data. Clubs are underway, and preparations for the Hispanic Heritage celebration are in progress, including a Foxcare student dance performance. Additionally, lunch charges have begun at \$3 per meal, with the PowerUp program available to support students in need.

V. School Improvement Plan Updates

MTSS schoolwide goal is that by June the cps team aims to achieve at least a 5% increase in FAST pm scores in both ela and math for all students.

Enhance impact on student outcomes. Teachers have access to appropriate tools to track data and are proficient in the use of them.

The MTSS schoolwide goal is to achieve at least a 5% increase in FAST PM scores for both ELA and Math across all students by June. To enhance student outcomes, teachers are equipped with the appropriate tools to effectively track data and are proficient in utilizing them.
