School/district updates

- Parents had questions about the phone call that was made by the principal regarding a threat that was made by a 6th Grade student about bringing a gun to school and it was "going to get real." In addition, he told four of his friends to stay home, which another student overheard. This student told his mom, who called the school immediately. The principal explained to the parents that the incident happened at dismissal, which was 2:40pm. By 3:10pm, the principal knew and immediately convened the threat management team to begin the reporting process. The principal did a call out and the BTM Chair began calling the homes of the four students to get their statements. The principal further explained that he was extremely disappointed in the four students who were told to stay home because they heard something but said nothing. This prompted the principal to hold an assembly the next morning with the 6th grade to emphasize how important it is to report threats as it is taken very seriously. This was a learning lesson for the students as well as the community.

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- The principal gave updates regarding the redefining process and the addition of 7th grade. Parents asked about electives, courses offered, clubs, athletics, and where the 7th grade will be located. The principal gave a complete report of what was happening in the district with other schools, and that the plan for our 7th grade was still a go. The principal gave further updates on the set up of the school for the addition of 7th and 8th grade, and a rundown of curriculum, electives, athletics, and clubs.
