- III. Approval of Previous Meeting's Minutes**
  - A. The minutes from the previous meeting were presented for review. A motion to approve the minutes was made by Elaine Heyman and seconded by Vaughn Reynolds. The motion passed unanimously.

will participate in writing assessments next week, while students in grades K through 2 will take the PM3 assessment. With only 47 days remaining in the school year, the current strategy is to focus intensely on individual student needs to determine necessary interventions.

- B. Dr. Leff also noted that an email was sent today regarding the Customer Survey, which includes a QR code for easy access. Students in grades 3 through 6 have access to the survey, though parents may choose to opt them out. Looking ahead to next year, the current Media Specialist will transition into a full-time role as the Magnet Coordinator. New academic offerings will include an Introduction to Aviation course, Spanish 1 and 2, and a Financial Literacy course where students will gain hands-on experience by operating a school store.
