- III. Approval of Previous Meeting's Minutes**

- IV. School Environmental Safety Incident Reporting (SESIR)**
 - A. The council reviewed the School Environmental Safety Incident Reporting (SESIR) data. It was noted that there were no incidents to report for the current period.
- V. Accountability Funds (if applicable)**
 - A. The status of school funds was reviewed. As of this meeting, the School Accountability Funds balance remains at \$3,401.22, and the School Recognition Funds balance is \$2,438.00.
- VI. School Improvement Plan Monitoring and Stakeholder Feedback**
 - A. There were no new updates or stakeholder feedback provided regarding the School Improvement Plan during this meeting.
- VII. Principal's Report**
 - A. Academic Progress and Assessment
 - 1. K-2 PM Testing: Progress Monitoring for grades K-2 is complete. Data indicates nearly all students showed growth from August to

May, with 1st-grade scores demonstrating exceptional improvement.

2. Upcoming Testing Schedule: During the week of May 4th, grades 3–6 will sit for the ELA PM3. The following week will be dedicated to Mathematics assessments. Additionally, 5th-grade students will complete their Science exams.
3. Data Review: Dr. Leff will provide a preliminary grade assessment at the next meeting, where the council will also review final scores and the upcoming budget.

B. New Elective Offerings (2026-2027)

1. Aviation & Robotics: An elective focusing on aviation and drone technology will be available to 6th and 7th-grade students.
2. Financial Literacy: Students will have the opportunity to manage the school store while gaining foundational skills in financial management.

C. School Events and Enrollment

1. The Kindergarten Kickoff (5/5/26) and the Magnet Showcase (5/18/26) are both scheduled for 6:00 PM. Student Ambassadors will be present to assist.
2. Enrollment Update: To date, the school has received 188 applications for grades K–7. Total current enrollment stands at 328 students.

D. Operations and Scheduling

1. Dismissal Procedures: Following a community survey regarding staggered versus collective dismissal, it has been determined that a staggered "STEAM time" model is not feasible due to current enrollment numbers.
2. Standardized Hours: Staff hours will be set from 7:30 AM to 3:00 PM.
3. Elementary: Instructional hours are 8:00 AM – 2:00 PM. Elementary students with middle school siblings will be supervised until 2:40 PM.
4. Middle School: The instructional day will run from 8:00 AM – 2:40 PM.
