

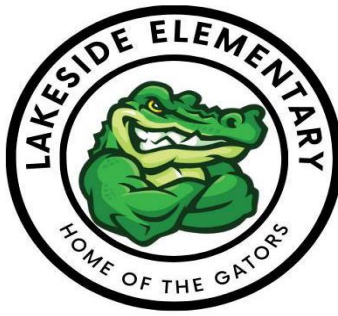

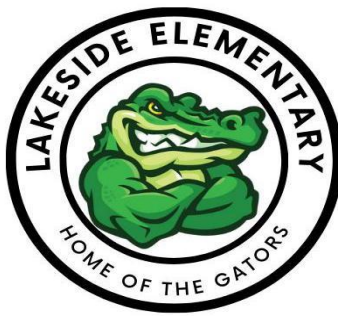

Meeting Minutes

- I. Roll Call to Establish Quorum
 - a. Meeting called to order at 2:22pm
 - b. SAC Members in attendance: Tara Biesel, Maria Amaro, Alexandria Chavez, Patty Deonarinae, Briana Gauiter, Ann-Sophie Lafortune, Georgina Lengnick, Yomaira Batista, Sherry Rini
 - c. We have met quorum, 9/13 members in attendance= 69%
 - d. 9 guests were in attendance
- II. Approval of November 19, 2025 Minutes
 - a. Minutes were approved unanimously
- III. Accountability Fund Balance- \$5,510.07
 - a. Voting on request to use funds for ELO Camps for reading and math- \$5,500
 - b. Request to use funds for ELOP camp=\$5,500.00
 1. ELA camps- Monday/Wednesday- 14 sessions X \$40= \$560x 5 teachers= \$2,800
 2. Math camps- Tuesday/Thursday- 11 sessions X \$40= \$440x5 teachers= \$2,200
 3. \$5,500 for teacher pay and \$500 for coordinator pay= \$5,500 total

- VI. School Improvement Plan Monitoring and Stakeholder Feedback
 - a. We are finishing up make-ups for PM2 FAST testing. We will present data once all testing has completed.
- VII. Florida School Recognition Program (A+ Funds) Proposals

- a. Ballot Creation Conversation: Mrs. Biesel reminded the SAC committee members that the following groups were not eligible for A+ funds: School Resource Officers, Substitutes, Contracted Employees- nurses and SLPs, any personnel not employed by Broward County Public Schools. The SAC committee was shown the district example ballot and Lakeside’s ballot from 2024-2025. Mrs. Biesel noted that the SAC committee members should be as specific as possible to who will receive the funds. Last year, the ballot said ALL faculty and staff and did not specify cafeteria, campus monitors, and facilities. Those groups would have to be added to the ballot if we wanted them to be included. During the conversation the group brought up that Lakeside has included everyone in the past. Mrs. Chavez motioned to have this added to the ballot. Mrs. Lafortune seconded the motion.
- b. Feedback from attendees: Mrs. Restrepo suggested adding a specific number of days that employees needed to work to receive the A+ funds. Mrs. Sanchez suggested that we have only two options this year. The second option usually involves a portion of the money going back to the school, and no one has voted for that option in the past. Mrs. Chavez motioned to approve the ballot. Mrs. Lafortune seconded the motion.







