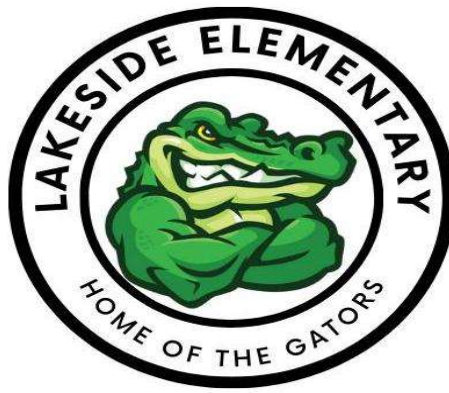

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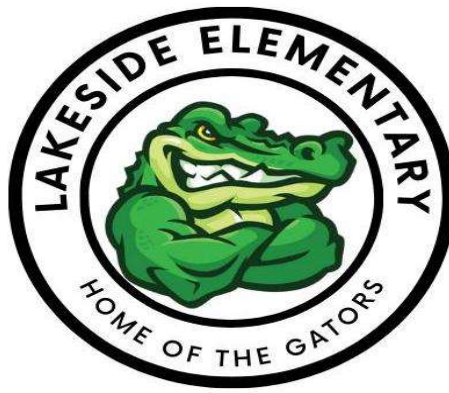

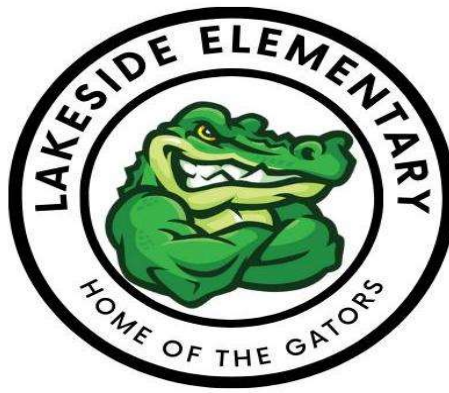

 - n. Kindergarten Early Literacy: PM 1: 10%, PM 2: 40%
 - o. Kindergarten Math: PM 1: 2%, PM 2: 29%
