

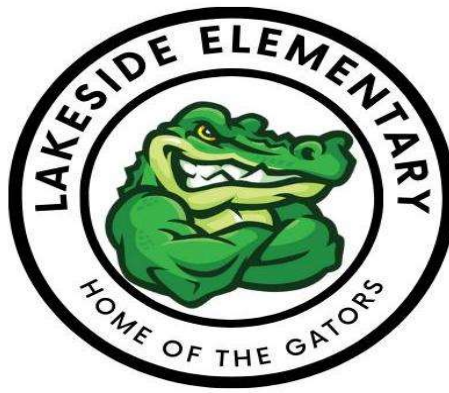

 - c. 5 guests were also in attendance
 - d. Meeting called to order at 2:23 pm
- II. Approval of February 26, 2025-Minutes
 - a. Minutes were approved unanimously
- III. Accountability Fund Balance- \$553.36
 - a. Our accountability fund balance remains the same.
 - b. AR Update- Students are still taking AR tests and earning a medal on the bulletin board when they reach their goal.
