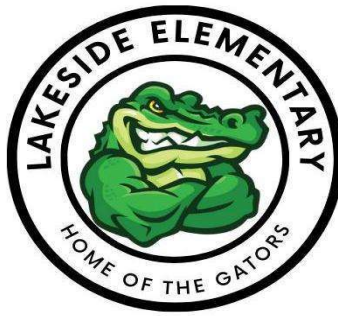

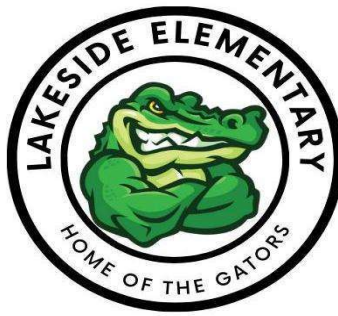

- I. Roll Call to Establish Quorum
 - a. Meeting called to order at 2:21pm
 - b. SAC Members in attendance: Maria Amaro, Yomaira Batista, Tara Biesel, Alexandria Chavez, Patty Deonarinae, Ann-Sofie Lafortune, Brianna Gaiter, Georgina Lengnick, Sherry Rini, Dr. Riquelme Rodriguez
 - c. We have met quorum, 10/13 members in attendance=77%
 - d. 5 guests were in attendance
- II. Approval of February 25, 2026, Minutes
 - a. Minutes were approved unanimously
- III. Accountability Fund Balance- \$10.07
 - a. ELO Camp Update
 - i. Camps are being held for reading and math FAST preparation
- IV. Title One Update
 - a. Parent and Family Engagement Plan
 - i. Based on this year's results and Title 1 survey
 - ii. PTA and SAC, Annual Open House, Literacy Night and Math Night
 - iii. Asked parents for feedback...no parent feedback was given
 - b. School Improvement Plan with Title One Addendum
 - i. Parents were given an opportunity to review the current plan and provide input to the upcoming plan. No feedback was given.
 - c. Parent Involvement Allocation
 - i. Dr. Rodriguez explained that the school's upcoming Parental Involvement allocation is used for parent and family engagement by purchasing agendas for students.
 - ii. Parents were asked for their feedback and Mrs. Lafortune stated that she agreed that it was good use of the funds.
 - d. School-Parent Compact
 - i. Review of the 25-26 compact and development of the upcoming year's School-Parent compact.

- ii. Asked parents for feedback...none was given
 - e. Title One Survey Funds / Results
 - i. Mrs. Restrepo went over the highlights from the school survey, including areas for growth.
 - ii. We went over the results of the parent survey. Overall, positive results but need growth in Title 1 participation and in SAC meetings.
 - iii. Title 1 set aside funds - Lakeside uses our set aside funds to purchase agendas for all students to improve family communication.
- V. Dr. Rodriguez spoke on the CLARIFICATION OF SCHOOL ADVISORY COUNCIL (SAC) ROLE IN SCHOOL FUNDING MEMO
 - a. What is SAC? The School Advisory Council (SAC) is a group made up of parents, teachers, staff, and community members who provide advice on school improvement priorities.
 - b. What SAC does and does not do: SAC does not control or manage school budgets and does not receive their own funding. Instead, they provide recommendations to support the School Improvement Plan (SIP).
 - c. How school funds are decided: School funds come from different sources (district, state, or federal), and each source has specific rules. All spending decisions are ultimately approved and managed by the school principal and district.
 - d. Funds that may carry over: Some limited funds- such as Teacher Classroom Supply Assistance (TCSA) and Florida School Recognition Funds- may carry over from year to year, depending on state rules. Most other funds must be used within the same school year.
 - e. Planning and accountability: Schools are encouraged to use funds in a timely manner to directly benefit students and align with the current school goals.
 - f. This clarification helps ensure transparency, responsible financial stewardship, and alignment with state and district guidelines.
