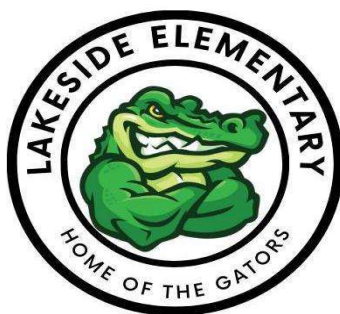

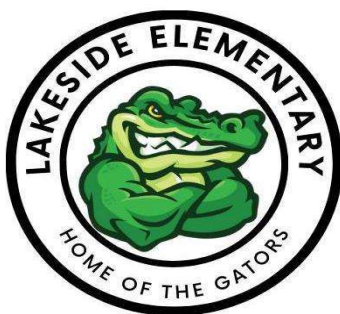

- I. Roll Call to Establish Quorum –
 - a. Meeting called to order at 2:24pm
 - b. Voted in a PreK parent- Melanie Cortes Ayala
 - c. SAC Members in attendance: Tara Biesel, Maria Amaro, Alexandria Chavez, Patty Deonarinae, Ann-Sofie Lafortune, Georgina Lengnick, Jennifer Lopez, Dana Qureshy, Sherry Rini
 - d. We have met quorum, 9/13 members in attendance=69%
 - e. 8 guests were also in attendance
- II. Approval of May 28,2025 Minutes and August 27,2025 Minutes
 - a. Minutes have been unanimously approved
- III. Accountability Fund Balance
 - a. Mrs. Leal stated that at this time, we do not have an update from the district. We are awaiting a new account balance.
- IV. Title One Update- Free and Reduced Lunch
 - a. Today was the first day that they charged students who did not qualify or apply for free/reduced lunch.
 - b. We're at 62% and need 65%.
- V. School Environmental Safety Incident Reporting (SESIR)
 - a. No SESIR events to report at this time.
- VI. School Wide Positive Behavior Plan (SBPB)
 - a. 36- Top 5 Behavior incidents last year
 - b. We're implementing all the rules consistently throughout the school.
 - c. We have CHAMPS posters, PBIS points, and Dojo Behavior Store
 - d. We're continuing to use CHAMPS and Positive Behavior Plans
 - e. Attendance is still a focus for our school. The school-wide attendance program was successful – it went from 43.53% to 78.78%.
- VII. Annual School Counseling and Support Plan
 - a. ASC goals: 2nd graders who are a level 1 from PM3 will increase in proficiency
 - b. ASC goal: 5th graders with office discipline referrals from 4th grade will have a decrease office discipline referrals this school year

- a. Varies monthly depending on what needs to be shared. We try to cover an area from our SIP at each meeting. We review data when it becomes available.
