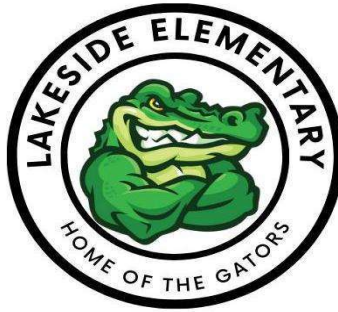

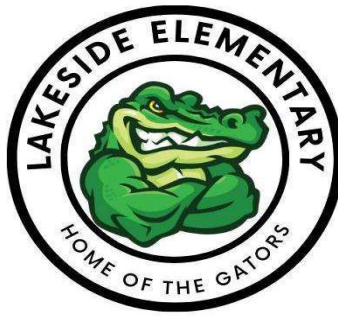

- I. Roll Call to Establish Quorum
 - a. Meeting called to order 2:33PM
 - b. SAC Members in attendance: Tara Biesel, Maria Amaro, Alexandria Chavez, Patty Deonarinae, Briana Gauiter, Ann-Sofie Lafortune, Georgina Lengnick, Dr. Riquelme Rodriguez
 - c. We have met quorum, 8/13 members in attendance= 62%
 - d. 5 guests were in attendance
- II. Approval of October 22, 2025, Minutes
 - a. Minutes approved motioned by Ms. Patty Deonarinae, Seconded by Ms. Restrepo
 - b. Minutes are approved
- III. Accountability Fund Balance
 - a. As of today, we have \$5,510.07
 - b. Request to use funds for ELOP camp=\$5,500.00
 1. ELA camps- Monday/Wednesday- 14 sessions X \$40= \$560x 5 teachers= \$2,800
 2. Math camps- Tuesday/Thursday- 11 sessions X \$40= \$440x5 teachers= \$2,200
 3. \$5,500 for teacher pay and \$500 for coordinator pay= \$5,500 total
 4. We will vote on using accountability funds for ELOP camp at the next meeting
- IV. Title One Update
 - a. Currently at 68%
- V. School Environmental Safety Incident Reporting (SESIR)
 - a. We have 1 SESIR event to report. Ms. Leal reported that it was battery. A student hit a teacher.
- VI. School Improvement Plan Monitoring and Stakeholder Feedback


- a. ELOP camps will be voted on at the next SAC meeting. This will help us work toward meeting our SIP goals. Students will be chosen for camp that need the extra push.
- VII. Florida School Recognition Program (A+ Funds) Information Update
 - a. This year we're getting \$39,364; last year it was \$72,903.
 - b. The district A+ PPT was shared with SAC so that everyone knows the process
 - i. The voting process must be completed by February 1, 2026- if school staff and SAC cannot reach an agreement by February 1, the awards will be equally distributed to all classroom teachers currently teaching in the school
 - ii. All 2024-2025 and/or 2025-2026 faculty and staff are eligible.
 - iii. The following are not eligible: School Resource Officers, Kelly substitutes, Contracted school nurses and SLPs, any personnel not employed by Broward County Public Schools
 - iv. Only SAC members may vote on the ballot creation, only one vote per member, a quorum must be present, votes will be taken by roll call and recorded in the meeting minutes
 - v. A choice of "none of the above" is required by state statute
 - vi. A left-over funds statement for each proposal option must be included- educational equipment and materials
 - vii. The principal is allowed to vote for the SAC ballot proposal, and the A+ funds staff vote
 - c. At the next SAC meeting the SAC members will work together to create a A+ funds ballot for faculty and staff to vote on.
