School Advisory Council (SAC) Minutes
August 28, 2025**

A meeting of Falcon Cove SAC was held at FCMS in the Nest Media Room. Judith Malone called the meeting to order at 8:37 am

A motion to accept March's minutes was approved.

Call to Order:

A meeting of the Falcon Cove Middle School Advisory Council was held in The Nest on August 28, 2025

SAC Chair Judith Malone called the meeting to order at 8:37 am

Secretary Kalondra Singh will record the minutes of this meeting.

Approval of Minutes:

Meeting minutes of May 2025 were considered.

Judith Malone - motioned to adopt the May 2025 Meeting Minutes. - *Florencia was added as a co-SAF chair - PTA new president Adelina Snell*

Meredith Schaller – 1st

Laurie Reichow – 2nd

Motion carried by unanimous voice vote.

Principal Report by Mr. Carruth: The 7/8th grade open house will be held on August 28, 2025. Falcon Cove's enrollment is healthy; the 10-day count is only at a difference of 4 students

compared to last year. Some of our funding is gone this year, so we will be looking at new ways to continue providing what we always have for our students.

We are seeking full staff participation in our PTSA; staff are eligible to receive a \$50 classroom grant upon joining PTSA.

PM1 Testing begins September 8th – the test is adaptive; students should strive to do their best so that they are able to have the opportunity to score higher; each test should be treated as the “real thing” because each test is important. Instructional time is not lost with our school’s bell schedule. We are asking that students are not picked up early after testing so that they may continue to receive instructional time with their teachers.

Budget Report and Updates by Mrs. Judith Malone: The SAC schedule has been posted, listing all meeting dates for the school year. Testing will start the week of September 8, 2025, and September 15, 2025. PM1 and PM2 will take place in study skills classes. The bell schedule has been amended, but it does not significantly impact instructional time. There is no extended time for accommodation because all the students will have it. If a teacher sees that a student is not actively testing, that student will not be allowed to go to the overflow room; PM1 is different than PM2/3. We want students to have a score for PM1 so that teachers can have that data. PM2 is extremely important, just as important as PM3 because matriculation for 8th graders starts in February, and the PM2 scores are used for course selection. The schedule for teachers this year is 105 minutes for testing, end of the day classes will be 70 minutes, and then reversed.

A new bell schedule has been implemented, showing the school’s new dismissal time of 4:05 PM. Clubs and organizations have been added to the school website.

We have no rollover funds; we are at \$0.00. Request for funds for ELA, Math for prep camp at the end of the last school year; there are no funds for that, and the request is being forwarded to PTSA.

Junior Achievement dates have been given; all dates for all school events have been posted to the school website. Junior Achievement requires volunteers

SESIR Report by Dr. Saddler: The SESIR report can be found on falconcove.net

SRO Report by Deputy Vasquez: The school was recently placed on “Secure”. When officers are working incidents that are close to schools, they will ask that nearby schools be placed on “secure” of precaution. These “secure” codes were caused by iguana hunters hunting nearby; this is legal, however, hunters are supposed to inform BSO that they will be hunting (time & date). This is not a threat; the hunters are contracted by the city. A secure code was placed on the school out of caution to confirm that it was, in fact, iguana hunters. A secure does not mean that there’s a threat; it happens usually because of our proximity to different incidents going on (I.e., serving warrants, iguana hunters, etc). Guns are not supposed to be within 1000 feet of a school;

however, city contracted vendors can surpass that law. City council is aware, and there are some changes that will be made to prevent an excess of secure / lockdown.
