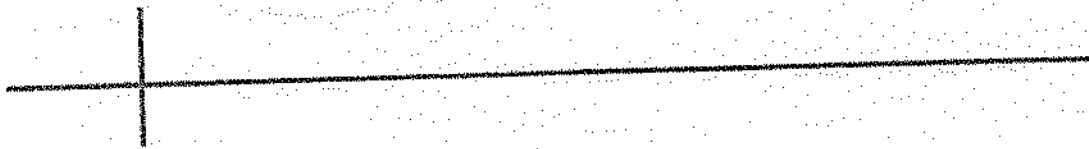

May 1, 2025

A meeting of Falcon Cove SAC was held at FCMS in the Nest Media Room. Judith Malone called the meeting to order at 8:34 am

A motion to accept March's minutes was approved.

**Call to Order:**

A meeting of the Falcon Cove Middle School Advisory Council was held in The Nest on May 1, 2025

SAC Chair Judith Malone called the meeting to order at 8:34 am

Secretary Kalondra Singh will record the minutes of this meeting.

**Approval of Minutes:**

Meeting minutes of April 2025 were considered.

Judith Malone - motioned to approve the April 2025 Meeting Minutes.

Kalondra Singh – 1<sup>st</sup>

Brian Fernandez – 2<sup>nd</sup>

Motion carried by unanimous voice vote.

**Principal Report by Mr. Carruth:** The projected budget has been given to Falcon Cove; the budget meeting is happening soon where the budget must be defended to the district. The projected budget for the 25 – 26 school year is only an estimate; around the second week of October is when it is finalized. The number of students in each program is also an estimate, as is

the number of staff to accommodate those students. The projection can and will change. The current projection is a budget based on 2036 students enrolling. We have 2067 students who have submitted a course card for the upcoming school year. One instructional position will be lost, two support positions will be lost, IDEA funding has been cut, and two positions will be lost because of this. No electives have been lost. Our SVE program will experience no change. There is no change in instructional support positions. We can hire a 4<sup>th</sup> assistant principal, however that money is being used to drive down class size and maintain our Behavior Specialist instead of hiring a 4<sup>th</sup> AP. The projected accountability funds for the 25 – 26 school year is \$0.00 No school has received accountability funds since 2020. The school recognition money is a separate payment; qualification process begins in November. Again, this is only a projection and there will not be a final number until the new school year begins.

**Budget Report and Updates by Mrs. Judith Malone:** May 1<sup>st</sup> is the final day for e-survey, and we have exceeded our goal of our school community's participation. School recognition is \$4400; accountability is \$4200. The next budget request will be for Saturday school and it will carry over into the new school year in August. The SIP plan must be done during pre-planning or before the end of the school year. There are several schools where class sizes are increasing to 37 – 40 in core classes and 150+ in P.E.
