School Improvement Monitoring and Feedback

2025 – 2026 SIP Areas of Focus:

By May 2026, the document sets goals to increase the percentage of students scoring proficient or higher in U.S. History and Biology from 89% to 90%, in Algebra from 67% to 68%, and in Reading proficiency from 78% to 79%, with a corresponding increase in reading learning gains for lower quartile students from 67% to 68%

Additionally, by the end of the 2025-2026 school year, it aims to raise the percentage of students passing at least one AP, AICE, or CTE exam or earning a grade of C or better in a Dual Enrollment course from 80% to 81%
