A suggestion was made for the ballot of 70% to instructional staff and 30% to all other staff. Approximate amount per person based on staff from 24-25 school year is \$620 per instructional staff member and \$423 per other.

A suggestion was made for paraprofessionals to be placed in a 3<sup>rd</sup> group.

Another suggestion was made for the ballot of 80% to instructional staff and 20% to all other staff. Approximate amount per person based on staff from 24-25 school year is \$770 per instructional staff and \$ 233 per other
