

The deadline to have your Q2 Interims in Focus is Monday, 11/17/25. That date has been emailed and on the school's calendar. Please note:

According to School Board Policy 4000, an interim report must be sent to parents of students experiencing difficulties no later than midway through the marking period. These difficulties include, but are not limited to:

- i. Receiving a below-average grade (Grades 3-5, a grade of D or F),
- ii. A significant drop of two or more grades,
- iii. Unacceptable behavior, and

iv. Excessiv



Teachers also have the ability to send an interim report home at any point during the school year if a concern arises that was not present at the midway point.

 - iii. Portables are in the process of being removed from campus. Two have already been removed and others will be removed soon. Mr. Peters would like to use the space as an open field area for student recess and physical activity.
 - iv. Accountability Funds may need to be used for academic camps this year.
 - v. Five year enrollment projection places Gator Run at less than 900 students in five years.








A+ Voting from SAC
