

School Advisory Council Meeting Minutes

General Meeting – Tuesday, January 27, 2026 – 2:30 PM

1. Call to order: A meeting of the Gator Run Elementary School SAC was held on Monday, January 27, 2025. SAC Chair- Mrs. Jacqueline Grasinger called the meeting to order at 2:30 p.m. Mr. Grasinger recorded the minutes of the meeting.
2. Introductions and Attendance – 8 members present, 10 members not present.
3. SAF Report
 - a. Updates about the school lunch program – concerns were raised about the healthiness of the food served at school lunch and about the size of the school lunch meals. Parents were concerned about the food served being enough for students and if the food served is healthy food for students to eat. Parents were surprised to learn that students can take two fruits and two vegetables and also that the lunch is cheaper if purchased in its entirety rather than only purchasing the parts that the student wants
4. Approval or correction of December meeting minutes – A motion was made by Ms. Goldberg to approve the December minutes. The minutes were approved unanimously.
5. Reports
 - a. Principal Report
 - i. Students are completing PM2 for I-Ready Reading and Math. This is a required assessment across Broward Schools. Data is used to compare to other assessment data to determine student achievement level and academic progress. Administration meets with teachers to discuss data and plan for future instruction for students. Gator Aide academic camp is part of the plan to meet student academic needs. Gator Aide is expected to begin around the middle of February and last until end of the year assessments for students.
 - b. Accountability Funds – \$12,038.57

6. Old Business
 - a. A+ Accountability ballot was approved and voted on by staff. Option #1 was the option that received the most votes

7. New Business

- a. Customer surveys are accessible on the school website. An example of the parent survey was shared with meeting attendees. The link is open to anybody throughout the school district. Anyone throughout the district can complete a survey for any other school in the district. The survey is broken into sections based on school-wide domain areas. Parents can complete the survey at home. Students will complete the survey at school, for those students in grades 3-5. It takes about 10-15 minutes to complete. This is different from the Life Skills and Wellness survey that students previously took at school. The data is used in a different way to measure different things about the students. The Life Skills and Wellness survey is more student-centered, while the student customer survey is more school-centered. Staff also take a staff survey with similar questions about school-wide issues. Surveys are completed every year in grades K-12. Parents can access previous survey data on the school website.
