General Meeting – Monday, May 19, 2025 – 2:30 PM

1. Call to order: A meeting of the Gator Run Elementary School SAC was held on Monday, May 19, 2025. SAC Chair- Mrs. Jacqueline Grasinger called the meeting to order at 2:30 p.m. Mr. Grasinger recorded the minutes of the meeting.
2. Introductions and Attendance – 5 members present, 8 members not present.
3. SAF Updates
 1. No Updates
4. Approval or correction of April meeting minutes – A motion was made by Mr. Braud to approve the April minutes. The minutes were approved unanimously.
5. Reports
 1. Accountability Funds – 16,793.08
 2. SESIR Incidents = 0
5. School Improvement Plan (SIP) Monitoring – School-Wide Positive Behavior Plan
6. Old Business – No Old Business to review
7. New Business – Nothing New to report
8. Principal's Report
 1. Budget Projection, not actual budget
 2. Money to district per student in October and February
 3. Projected enrollment for next year is 1128 students, down from 1174
 4. Money budgeted to Instructional, Support, Categorical, IDEA categories
 5. Total budget projection is \$5.3 million
 6. 2 classroom teaching positions lost – 51 total classroom teachers
 7. Specials classes will remain the same from current school year
 8. Special Programs – PreK and VPK programs – AM/PM program discontinued
 9. Instructional Support positions will remain the same as current year
 10. Other support positions will remain the same except for 3 less Education Support Professional positions
 11. School Accountability funds will be approximately \$17,000
 12. A+ funds will be voted on and disbursed for next year
 13. Current budget numbers are a projection and relate to positions and not particular people

 1. Continuing and expanding after school reading and math camps
 2. Recognizing and continuing work in areas that are already improved
