






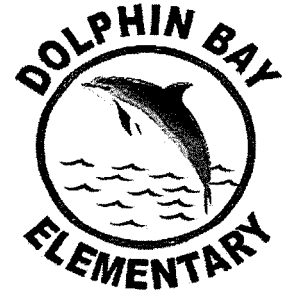

New Business and Mrs. Khadour's Updates from i-Zone Meeting:

Ms. Khadour provided an update regarding cafeteria funds and available balances. She shared that the district has two remaining years on the MySchoolBucks contract and will explore alternative options at that time due to the service fees parents incur when adding money online. Additionally, efforts are underway to review and enhance the lunch menu to make it more appealing to students.

Ms. Nelson discussed the upcoming school closures within Broward County Public Schools and provided an overview of the redistribution plan for affected students. The schools approved for closure include Sunshine Elementary School in Miramar, Panther Run Elementary School in Pembroke Pines, Palm Cove Elementary School in Pembroke Pines, North Fork Elementary School in Fort Lauderdale, Plantation Middle School in Plantation, and Seagull Alternative High School in Fort Lauderdale. These closures impact schools in the South, Central, and North Regions. Students from the closing schools will be reassigned and distributed to neighboring campuses based on district capacity and zoning adjustments. Additional information will be communicated to families directly from the district as plans are finalized.

Ms. Khadour provided information regarding Hazel Health services. She explained that, under Broward County Public Schools guidelines, a full time school nurse is typically assigned only when a campus has a medically fragile or diabetic student enrolled. In BCPS, "medically fragile" refers to a student with significant or complex health conditions that require ongoing medical monitoring, specialized procedures, or skilled nursing care during the school day.

In the absence of an on site nurse, Hazel Health serves as a telehealth provider, allowing students to access virtual medical care with the assistance and supervision of a designated office staff member.

The Entrepreneur Education & Development Center came to advertise what they provide. Dolphin Bay is looking into them for next school year for fundraising.

Next Meeting: The next SAC meeting is scheduled for March 2, 2026 directly after the SAC meeting, in the Media Center.
