




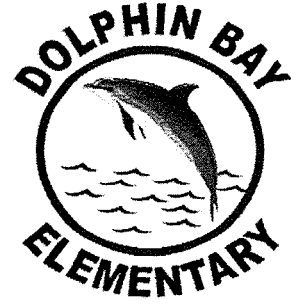

**School Improvement Plan (SIP)**

Dolphin Bay Elementary's Accountability Funds balance is \$10,670.21

The School Advisory Council reviewed Dolphin Bay Elementary's School Improvement Plan mid year data in alignment with Broward County Public Schools strategic priorities. The review included analysis of FAST progress monitoring results, iReady diagnostic growth, SESIR data trends, attendance data, and ongoing intervention supports to ensure continuous academic improvement.

Mid year data reflects a continued focus on closing achievement gaps through standards aligned instruction, targeted small group interventions, MTSS implementation, and consistent progress monitoring. In response to identified academic needs, Academic

Camps began on February 23rd to provide additional targeted support and close skill gaps based on student performance data.

The SAC will continue to monitor progress toward SIP goals to ensure alignment with BCPS priorities of increasing student achievement, maintaining safe and supportive schools, and strengthening stakeholder engagement.

**New Business and Mrs. Khadour's Updates from Everglades i-Zone Meeting:**

Ms. Khadour provided an update from the February 20, 2026, Everglades Innovation Zone Parent Meeting that was held at Sunset Lakes Elementary School. District representatives provided an overview of the Everglades Innovation Zone structure, which aligns feeder pattern schools in the South Region to promote continuity in academic programming, shared resources, and collaborative planning from elementary through high school. The purpose of the Innovation Zone model was to strengthen student achievement, increase enrollment stability, and ensure strategic use of district resources.

Presenters discussed current enrollment trends, projected student distribution, and the impact of district wide right sizing efforts. Information was shared regarding academic alignment across schools within the zone, including curriculum consistency, intervention supports, and opportunities for advanced coursework. Families were also informed about ways to remain engaged through SAC, SAF, PTA, and district advisory committees.

The meeting concluded with a question and answer session, allowing parents to seek clarification regarding zoning boundaries, transportation considerations, school capacity,
