

## January School Advisory Council Minutes:

### Call to Order:

The January meeting of the Park Lakes Elementary School Advisory Council was scheduled for 1/27/2026 @ 5:00pm.

### Minutes:

- I. The meeting began with a Welcome to everyone present and the pledge was recited by all.
- II. The minutes were reviewed and a motion to approve the minutes was done with no corrections needed.
- III. **Principal Updates**-Ms. Parris greeted and thanked everyone for coming out. The purpose of the SAC meetings was once again discussed with the participants.
  - a. **Curriculum Updates** – Park Lakes completed the F.A.S.T., STARR PM2, the Science Middle of the Year Assessments and the i-Ready Diagnostics #2. Assessment results were being reviewed, and Data-Chats will be held with teachers to discuss the results.
  - b. **School Environment Safety Incident Report** - There was no incident reported for the month of January.

The floor was opened to receive question/concerns from parents. There were no concerns or questions raised.

- IV. **School Accountability Funds Review**- The School Accountability Funds allocated for the 2025-2026 school year is \$5,311.00. The School Recognition funds allocated for the 2025-2026 school year is \$9,323.00.
  - i. A motion was brought before the committee for consideration and approval to cover payment of \$220.68 for ELO tutoring camps commencing February 2026.
  - ii. A motion was brought forward for \$2,500 to cover the cost to purchase snacks and juices for the 25-26 ELA and Mathematics FAST Assessments for Grades 3-5 in May 2026.
  - iii. The items were approved by the SAC Committee members by a majority vote of 22 members out of 24 members (2 members were inadvertently absent).
- V. **Parent Teachers' Association (PTA)** – Ms. Austin reminded the parents of the importance of joining the PTA and that interested parties can get in touch with Mrs. Green through the front office. The membership fee is \$10.00. She also noted that donations and sponsoring are always accepted
- VI. **Title 1 Updates**- Participants were encouraged to participate actively in identifying local businesses that could partner with the school, emphasizing the significance of community involvement.
- VII. **Discussion & Questions:** The floor was open for further questions and discussions. No concerns or questions were raised.
