- Tiffany Haynes explains there is a component in SAC meetings called Train the Council, where she'll go over different things that governs the meeting. SAC will need to come up with 2 proposals with a 3rd being none of the above. SAC members asked what was decided for previous A+ funding. The Committee selected December 4th to have a meeting specifically to come up with proposals.

1. Collection Development Plan (Lissette De La Torre)
 - The purpose of the collection Development of school Library Collection development plan serves as a road map to guide library material selection, acquisition and maintenance. It ensures the collection aligns with Florida statues the districts. Plan goals and guardrails the school's curriculum and student needs by providing framework for choosing resources that best support students learning across different subjects and interests, while also addressing diversity and appropriate current levels. The goal of collection development is to ensure the collection has information sources inadequate quantity to support students academic and personal. Davenport asks about specific lists and Ms. De La Torre responds that there are Florida laws that we must stay in compliance, which we are. The main focus this year is nonfiction and easy books and to remove older books. Next year's focus will be fiction and graphic novels. The plan will be made public mid-December.
