School Recognition Award FRQs

Florida Statute 1008.36.

What exactly does the statute say?

The 1008.36 Florida School Recognition Program states:

1. "The Legislature finds that there is a need for a performance incentive program for outstanding faculty and staff in highly productive schools. The Legislature further finds that performance-based incentives are commonplace in the private sector and should be infused into the public sector as a reward for productivity.
2. The Florida School Recognition Program is created to provide financial awards to public schools that: (a) Sustain high performance by receiving a school grade of "A," making excellent progress; or (b) Demonstrate exemplary improvement due to innovation and effort by improving a letter grade.
3. All public schools, including charter schools, that receive a school grade pursuant to s. 1008.34 are eligible to participate in the program.
4. All selected schools shall receive financial awards depending on the availability of funds appropriated and the number and size of schools selected to receive an award. Funds must be distributed to the school's fiscal agent and placed in the school's account and must be used for purposes listed in subsection (5) as determined jointly by the school's staff and school advisory council. If school staff and the school advisory council cannot reach agreement by February 1, the awards must be equally distributed to all classroom teachers currently teaching in the school.
5. School recognition awards must be used for the following:
 1. Nonrecurring bonuses to the faculty and staff;
 2. Nonrecurring expenditures for educational equipment or materials to assist in maintaining and improving student performance; or
 3. Temporary personnel for the school to assist in maintaining and improving student performance. Notwithstanding statutory provisions to the contrary, incentive awards are not subject to collective bargaining."

What does nonrecurring mean?

Nonrecurring means one-time only.

The Proposals/Ballot FRQs

Who makes proposals on how to spend the money?

The School Advisory Council (SAC) creates proposals, but the faculty and staff must approve by secret ballot.

What if individuals don't like the SAC proposals?

They can cast their vote for "None of the Above".

If all SAC proposals fail, what happens?

SAC develops more proposals and presents it/them for another vote.

Can we elect to do a combination of things with the money, or must it be spent for one purpose?

The money may be divided among several projects, i.e., bonus plus equipment/material or bonus plus temporary staff, etc.

Can the principal add his/her proposal(s) to the ballot?

No, all proposals must be developed through SAC.

Can the school share money with other district schools?

Yes, if it is a SAC proposal and a majority of the staff vote to approve it.

How many proposals does the SAC need to give to the employees?

The SAC may create several proposals, although the final vote may be a choice of one (1) or two (2) proposal(s) and a choice of none of the above.

How are the SAC proposals communicated to the faculty and staff at the school?

They are posted a minimum of three days in prominent locations so that all faculty and staff have the opportunity to view them.

Voting FRQs

Who votes?

All school employees currently on staff.

Can past employees who transferred to another location vote?

No.

What is a majority vote?

The greater number of school employees voting.

Can parents vote?

No. But if they are voting members of SAC, they can help develop proposals for use of funds.

Can a faculty or staff member who is absent on the day of voting vote?

Absent employees who return to work no later than one (1) work day after the election may vote.

The Bonus FRQS

Who is eligible for a bonus?

Current and past employees of the school, including those on leave, as well as temporary and substitute personnel, if they are included in the SAC proposal and it passes with a majority vote.

Can staff who transferred (voluntary or involuntary) to another school get the bonus?

Yes, if it is in the SAC proposal and it passes with a majority vote.

Note: Staff should consider those employees who were transferred and make a conscious choice if they will be included.

Can retirees receive the bonus?

Yes, if it is in the SAC proposal and it passes with a majority vote. This bonus will not affect their retirement benefits.

Are administrators, non-instructional, part-time, temps and subs eligible?

Yes, if that is in the SAC proposal and it passes with a majority vote.

Does everyone get the same amount?

It is up to SAC and the vote. They can choose to give different amounts to different classifications.




Minutes:

- Call to Order and establish quorum. Quorum is established at 3:17pm with 40 members in attendance out of 55.
- Approval and Corrections of November Minutes-Ethan Persten made finals for the 200 freestyle. And the relay was 400 meters.
 - Fabio Castillo ranked third in cross-country.
 - Karla Figueroa is with a “K”
 - Mr. DeLeeuw said “Students count on those study hall classes”.
 - Carol is spelled without an “E”.
 - “Danielle Bradley “doesn’t care what she teaches or when”
 - “If we don’t take action”
- Akira Edmond motioned to accept the minutes for November. Blen Ayalew seconded.
- Principal’s Report-Dr. Kaplan was unable to attend the meeting. Mr. Wood had nothing for the Principal’s report.

- PTSS Report-There will be two Score at the Top SAT courses that will be available for the March and May SAT. No dates yet. Dates must be approved. The teacher luncheon was a success and much appreciated.
- SIP Monitoring

- Accountability funds-the current fund stands at \$17,709.86. As detentions are funded (approved request for funds), the money will decrease.
- SESIR (School Environmental Safety Incident Reporting)-October and November data has not been posted.
- Old Business –A+ Ballot proposals discussion, creation, and vote. Voting process must be by February 1, 2026. Money can be used to reward faculty and non-faculty bonuses, buying educational equipment. The faculty vote will be January 5th. Outcome of the vote will be discussed on January 26th. Mrs. Ackerman explained the voting results from the faculty and staff feedback survey given out the previous week. 78% of staff and faculty polled supported sharing bonuses with faculty and staff. Mrs. Ackerman shared narrative feedback from faculty and staff: There were some questions as to whether interim subs could be included. They can be included if SAC votes to include them. Mrs. Gebbia asked what the vote was last year or the last year we were eligible? And were subs included? The answers were that faculty and non-faculty were included last year. Subs were not. Mrs. Scott wished to clarify that an interim substitute is taking over the class for the remainder of the year. If an interim sub is not found, the class is split up and given to existing faculty to teach. Most of the public comments supported sharing the bonus money with faculty and non-faculty because “all staff contribute to the success of the students”. Mrs. Tortorella asked how many interim subs there were last year. There were 4 interim subs last year. Roxanne Brissett motioned to vote whether we should include interim subs in the money. Carrie Forsyth seconded. Beth Ackerman led the vote. The vote was unanimous to not include interim subs. Mrs. Brissett began the ballot discussion if there were no further comments.

- For the proposed ballot: Proposal 1 is 100% of the funds for a one-time bonus to be divided among 2024-25 faculty (instructional) and staff (noninstructional) members. Staff must have worked at least 99 days of the 2024-25 school year (per the 186- day calendar) to receive the bonus. Mrs. Forsyth asked teachers how they felt about the 99 days requirement. Teachers present said they felt fine about it.
- Proposal 2: 100% of the funds for a one-time bonus to be divided among 2024-2025 faculty (instructional) members. Staff must have worked at least 99 days of the 2024-2025 school year (per the 186- day calendar) to receive the bonus.
- Proposal 3 would be “None of the above.” Mrs. Brissett said that we must have none of the above as an option. She then asked for a motion to approve.
- Beth Ackerman motioned to approve the ballot as outlined above. Carrie Forsyth seconded.
- Mrs. Brissett asked Mrs. Ackerman to conduct a roll call vote. The ballot was adopted by unanimous vote with all 35 members who were present at the time of the vote agreeing to the ballot with the 3 options above. Five members left prior to the vote.
- **New Business – Janet Chung presented about DECA. She is the VP of Marketing of DECA. She wanted to let us know about what DECA has done so far this year. DECA is a student organization that prepares students for careers in marketing and business. Recently leaders from the chapter project (Financial Literacy Education) spoke with students at Sawgrass Springs Middle School. They also had a DECA breakfast where interested students were able to come learn more about DECA.**
- **SAF– Mrs. Morst gave the report. For payment of lunch, there will be no more courtesy meals. If you don’t have money, it will be charged to your lunch debt. You will have to pay that debt off the same as any other obligation. The District is \$300,000 in debt for lunch. If you get a la carte items, you will have to pay cash. You**

will not be able to charge those. This is retroactive to October 1st. There will be 1,000 layoffs across the District this year. The District has lost \$100 million in funding due to declining enrollment. Acceleration rollover funding – the CFO says there is no money to give back to the schools for acceleration. It rolled into general funds even though that is prevented by state law. The Superintendent said all acceleration programs will be funded the way they need to be. There has been a flood of emails to District from community stakeholders that they want to see acceleration money being returned to schools.

- Adjournment – Danielle Tortorella motioned to adjourn the meeting at 4:26. Fiorella Camperos seconded.
