- SESIR (School Environmental Safety Incident Reporting)-The SESIR has not been updated. Officer Burton says since COVID our SESIR numbers have been happily low.
- Old Business
 - A+ Ballot update- Mrs. Brissett reminded the group that we voted on the distribution of A+ funds since our last meeting. 85% of the vote supported 100% of the funds would be distributed equally among instructional and non-instructional staff. The vote had to be held twice. During the first vote there were 3 more votes cast than signatures on the roster. The re-vote on the 12th had no issues. Documentation was submitted to the District on January 14th.
 - Midyear Report update- We have to examine our progress in Math Proficiency, ELA/Reading Learning Gains (Our goal: By June of 2026, Coral Glades Grades 9-10 will increase student proficiency in FAST ELA) and ELA/Reading Lowest Quartile.
- New Business
 - Continuation Waivers (PSD and Exam Exemption Process-This year was the first year that students in EOC classes could not exempt midterms. We will look at the data from this year. We have four more years on this waiver. Only the faculty could end this waiver by a vote. All
