SAF Meeting

Called to order at 3:55pm

Mrs. Morst said all people present at the SAC meeting are eligible to be members. Mrs. Morst is the SAF chair.

Roxanne Brissett nominated Nicole Morst to serve another term. Dr. Danielle Bradley seconded. It was unanimous.

Mrs. Morst motioned to elect a co-chair. She nominated Carla Figueroa. Roxanne Brissett seconded. It was unanimous.

Mrs. Morst nominated Mr. Alonso as Secretary. Mrs. Brissett seconded. It was unanimous.

Mrs. Morst reminded those present that SAF leaders represent the interest of parents to the District level. Some of the things parents have changed is the homework policy, the calendar (got it to be adopted for two years instead of one).

The District is getting vape detectors. They want to introduce them at the middle school. The vape detectors also have AI that can indicate mention of words like "fight" or "gun". The Board said it would be at ALL schools for middle school and high schools BY THE END OF THE YEAR. Security chief for the District Chief Gregory will give a presentation on this at Monarch High School October 16th at 6pm.

Hazel Health is a tele-health service available to all Broward County students. It has been at the District for the past three years.

FOCUS – there were concerns about 504s not being in FOCUS. Mrs. Brissett said the 504s in FOCUS are not detailed enough. But they are being sent to teachers by the secretary. Ms. Morst said 504s and Behavior Threat Assessments will be incorporated into FOCUS more effectively.

Tuesday, September 30th at Coral Springs High School they will be discussing the reconfiguring of Sawgrass Springs Middle School, Coral Springs Middle, Forest Glen and Margate Middle schools.

Haley Swickle represented Coral Glades at Superintendent's Roundtable. Many of those students said they did not have enough access to guidance counselors to help them in crisis because the counselors are busy with scheduling.

Mrs. Brissett says she has to set up a table in the front office with flyers of information for parents. She asked SAF to provide whatever information they would like to share.
